AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge on that portion of T.R. 413 over the
2 Raystown Branch of the Juniata River, Juniata Township,
3 Bedford County, as the Army Specialist Four Harold Phillip
4 Grasser Memorial Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Army Specialist Four Harold Phillip Grasser Memorial
8 Bridge.

9 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
10 follows:

11 (1) Army Specialist Four Harold Phillip Grasser served
12 with the United States Army during the Vietnam War and was a
13 native of Manns Choice.

14 (2) Army Specialist Four Grasser was killed in action on
15 August 30, 1968.

16 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on T.R. 413 on Grasser
17 Road in Juniata Township, Bedford County, on that portion of

1 Grasser Road over the Raystown Branch of the Juniata River at
2 the intersection of New Baltimore Road, is designated the Army
3 Specialist Four Harold Phillip Grasser Memorial Bridge.

4 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
5 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
6 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

7 Section 2. Effective date.

8 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
