Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in size, weight and load, further providing for 2 maximum gross weight of vehicles and for maximum axle weight of vehicles. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 4941 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 9 § 4941. Maximum gross weight of vehicles. * * * 10 (c.1) Exception. -- A municipal - owned three - axle motor vehicle 11 may exceed the 58,400 pound maximum gross weight under 12 subsection (c) if the gross weight is not more than the 13 14 vehicle's gross vehicle weight rating or 66,000 pounds, 15 whichever is less. * * * 16

- 13 <u>APPLICABLE TO INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS EXCEPT FOR A HIGHWAY ADDED</u>
