AN ACT

- 1 Establishing the Weigh Station Preclearance Program; and
- 2 providing for criteria for preclearance system and devices
- and for data access.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- This act shall be known and may be cited as the Weigh Station
- 8 Preclearance Program Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Preclearance system provider." A provider of the
- 14 preclearance system under section 4(a).
- 15 "Program." The Weigh Station Preclearance Program
- 16 established under section 3(a).

- 1 "Weigh station." A roadside station where commercial
- 2 vehicles are required to stop for weight and safety inspections
- 3 by the Pennsylvania State Police.
- 4 Section 3. Establishment and operation of program.
- 5 (a) Establishment.--The

- 6 (A) ESTABLISHMENT.--THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:
- 7 (1) THE Pennsylvania State Police shall establish the
- 8 Weigh Station Preclearance Program in accordance with the
- 9 commercial vehicle information systems and networks
- 10 electronic screening truck inspection and weigh station
- 11 preclearance standards authorized by the Federal Motor
- 12 Carrier Safety Administration.
- 13 (2) ANY PROPOSED INFRASTRUCTURE TO BE INSTALLED WITHIN
- 14 THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF A STATE HIGHWAY MUST BE DESIGNED AND
- 15 CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARDS FROM THE DEPARTMENT
- OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE COMMISSION,
- 17 AS APPLICABLE, AND REVIEWED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 18 TRANSPORTATION AND THE PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE COMMISSION, AS
- 19 APPLICABLE, FOR APPROVAL PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION. ALL COSTS
- 20 ASSOCIATED WITH THE DESIGN, INSPECTION, INSTALLATION,
- 21 MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE PRECLEARANCE SYSTEM SHALL BE
- THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PRECLEARANCE SYSTEM PROVIDER.
- 23 (b) Operation. -- The Pennsylvania State Police shall operate
- 24 the program at each location where commercial vehicle
- 25 enforcement is conducted. A preclearance system provider's
- 26 devices and platform shall be used uniformly at each location
- 27 where the program is operated in accordance with section 4.
- 28 (c) Standards. -- The Pennsylvania State Police shall
- 29 establish standards for the program in order to meet the needs
- 30 of this Commonwealth and conform with weigh station

- 1 preclearance programs in other states, including standards
- 2 regarding safety history credential status.
- 3 Section 4. Criteria for preclearance system and devices.
- 4 (a) Preclearance system. -- The program shall be administered
- 5 by a preclearance system. The preclearance system shall meet all
- 6 of the following criteria:
- 7 (1) The preclearance system shall be $\frac{GPS-based}{GPS-BASED}$ <--
- 8 OR INFRASTRUCTURE-BASED and be able to be used at both fixed
- 9 enforcement facilities and mobile or remote locations.
- 10 (2) The preclearance system shall be broadly deployed
- 11 across the United States for interstate operability purposes
- on the effective date of this section and be accessible by a <--
- 13 wide range of in-cab commercial radio services network
- 14 devices.
- 15 (b) Additional equipment. Installation of additional
- 16 equipment within or adjacent to a roadway shall not be required
- 17 for the purpose of communication with devices operating within-
- 18 the preclearance system under subsection (a).
- 19 $\frac{\text{(c)}}{\text{SECTION}}$.
- 20 (B) Software and hardware. -- Computer software and hardware,
- 21 INCLUDING ANY INFRASTRUCTURE-BASED DEVICES OR TECHNOLOGIES, that <--

- 22 is necessary for the use of the preclearance system under
- 23 subsection (a) shall be made available at no cost to the
- 24 Pennsylvania State Police. The preclearance system provider
- 25 shall be responsible for all costs of operating and maintaining
- 26 the computer software and hardware. The computer software and
- 27 hardware shall meet all of the following criteria:
- 28 (1) The computer software and hardware shall meet the
- 29 requirements of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety
- 30 Administration for core compliance with the commercial

- 1 vehicle information systems and networks electronic screening
- 2 truck inspection and weigh station preclearance standards.
- 3 (2) In-vehicle equipment shall be operated in compliance
- 4 with applicable State law and regulations relating to hands
- 5 free devices and distracted driving.
- 6 (3) Preclearance messaging shall be transmitted and
- 7 received by the driver through electronic messaging within
- 8 the cab of the commercial vehicle.
- 9 Section 5. Data access.
- 10 The Pennsylvania State Police, THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 11 TRANSPORTATION AND THE PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE COMMISSION, AS
- 12 APPLICABLE, shall have unrestricted access to roadside event
- 13 data provided by the preclearance system under section 4(a) as

- 14 part of the program, including real-time event data and real-
- 15 time sensor data.
- 16 Section 6. Regulations.
- 17 The Pennsylvania State Police may establish policies,
- 18 standards, rules and regulations as necessary to implement the
- 19 provisions of this act, including authorized devices that meet
- 20 the requirements under section $\frac{4(c)}{4(B)}$ 4(B) for use in the program. <--
- 21 Section 7. Consultation.
- The Pennsylvania State Police may consult with the Department
- 23 of Transportation as necessary for the implementation of this
- 24 act.
- 25 Section 8. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 180 days.
