## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of May 1, 1984 (P.L.206, No.43), entitled "An
- act providing for safe drinking water; imposing powers and
- duties on the Department of Environmental Resources in
- 4 relation thereto; and appropriating certain funds," providing
- for maximum contaminant levels.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. The act of May 1, 1984 (P.L.206, No.43), known as
- 9 the Pennsylvania Safe Drinking Water Act, is amended by adding a
- 10 section to read:
- 11 <u>Section 4.1. Maximum contaminant levels.</u>
- 12 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding section 4(a), the maximum
- 13 contaminant level for polyfluoroalkyl or perfluorinated
- 14 substances, including, but not limited to, perfluorooctane
- 15 sulfonate, perfluorooctanoic acid, perfluorononanoic acid and
- 16 perfluorohexane sulfonic acid, shall not exceed 10 parts per
- 17 trillion, until such time as subsection (b)(1), (2) or (3) is
- 18 satisfied.

- 1 (b) Testing. -- A maximum contaminant level for a substance
- 2 <u>under subsection (a) must be established by one of the</u>
- 3 <u>following:</u>
- 4 (1) The Environmental Quality Board.
- 5 (2) An executive order of the Governor.
- 6 (3) The United States Environmental Protection Agency.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
