AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in fishing licenses, providing for first
- 3 responders.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 30 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 2707.3. First responders.
- 9 <u>(a) Resident fishing license. -- A first responder who meets</u>
- 10 the qualifications under section 2701 (relating to resident
- 11 <u>fishing licenses</u>) shall be issued an annual resident fishing
- 12 license at the cost of \$1 upon application to the commission or
- 13 <u>a county treasurer. An application submitted by a first</u>
- 14 responder shall, in addition to any information required under
- 15 <u>section 2701, contain a statement that the applicant is a first</u>
- 16 <u>responder</u>.
- 17 (b) Proof of eligibility. -- The commission shall develop
- 18 guidelines for establishing proof of eligibility for a resident

- 1 <u>fishing license under this section.</u>
- 2 (c) Issuance. -- The commission may not issue a resident
- 3 fishing license under this section on or after December 31,
- 4 2022.
- 5 (d) Definition. -- As used in this subsection, a "first
- 6 <u>responder" means any of the following:</u>
- 7 (1) A law enforcement officer, a firefighter, an
- 8 <u>emergency medical technician</u>, an emergency service
- 9 <u>dispatcher</u>, an ambulance driver or any other similar
- individual who is deemed by the commission to respond to
- 11 <u>requests for emergency assistance.</u>
- 12 (2) A corrections officer at a correctional institution
- as defined under 61 Pa.C.S. § 102 (relating to definitions).
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
