AN ACT

- 1 Prohibiting vaccination, isolation and quarantine mandates,
- vaccination without consent and vaccination mandates by
- business entities and ticket issuers; and imposing penalties.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Vaccine
- 8 Freedom Act.
- 9 Section 2. Declaration of purpose.
- 10 The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
- 11 (1) The enactment of a State law protecting residents of
- 12 this Commonwealth from coerced vaccination and discrimination
- 13 based on their vaccination status is necessary to protect the
- individual rights of residents of this Commonwealth as
- 15 recognized by the United States Constitution and the
- 16 Constitution of Pennsylvania.
- 17 (2) It is the General Assembly's intent to universally

- 1 prohibit and wholly occupy the field of vaccination mandates
- 2 within this Commonwealth.
- 3 Section 3. Definitions.
- 4 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 5 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 6 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 7 "Business entity." A person or group of persons performing
- 8 or engaging in any activity, enterprise, profession or
- 9 occupation for gain, benefit, advantage or livelihood, whether
- 10 for profit or not for profit. The term includes any of the
- 11 following:
- 12 (1) A self-employed individual, an entity that files an
- article of incorporation, a partnership, a limited
- partnership, a limited liability company, a foreign
- 15 corporation, a foreign limited partnership or a foreign
- limited liability company authorized to transact business in
- 17 this State.
- 18 (2) A business trust or an entity that registers as a
- business with the Secretary of State of the Commonwealth.
- 20 (3) An entity that possesses a business license, permit,
- 21 certificate, approval, registration, charter or similar form
- of authorization issued by the Commonwealth.
- 23 (4) An entity that is exempt by the laws of this
- 24 Commonwealth from obtaining a business license.
- 25 (5) An entity that is unlawfully operating in this
- 26 Commonwealth without a business license.
- 27 "COVID-19 disaster emergency." The duration of the
- 28 proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on
- 29 March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and
- 30 any renewal of the state of disaster emergency.

- 1 "Department." The Department of Health of the Commonwealth.
- 2 "Municipality." A county, city, borough, incorporated town
- 3 or township.
- 4 "State of disaster emergency." A state of disaster emergency
- 5 declared by executive order or proclamation of the Governor
- 6 under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to general authority of
- 7 Governor).
- 8 "Ticket issuer." An individual or entity that provides
- 9 tickets to an entertainment event. The term includes any of the
- 10 following:
- 11 (1) The operator of a venue where the entertainment
- 12 event occurs.
- 13 (2) The sponsor or promoter of the entertainment event.
- 14 (3) A sports team that participates in the entertainment
- event or a league with teams that participate in the
- 16 entertainment event.
- 17 (4) A theater company, musical group or similar
- 18 participant in an entertainment event.
- 19 (5) An agent of an individual or entity specified under
- 20 paragraph (1), (2), (3) or (4).
- 21 "Vaccination." The introduction of a vaccine into the body
- 22 to produce immunity to a specific disease or virus.
- 23 Section 4. Vaccination, isolation and quarantine mandates
- 24 prohibited.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the following
- 26 shall apply:
- 27 (1) The Governor, the department, a State agency, a
- board or commission, a county executive or a governing body
- of a municipality may not adopt or enforce a State law, an
- ordinance, a regulation, a rule or an order that mandates any

- 2 (i) The vaccination, immunization, genetic
 3 modulation or inoculation of an individual at any time,
 4 including during the COVID-19 disaster emergency or any
 5 other state of disaster emergency or during a period of
 6 insurrection or martial law.
 - (ii) The isolation or quarantine of an individual based solely or primarily on an individual's vaccination status at any time, including during the COVID-19 disaster emergency or any other state of disaster emergency or during a period of insurrection or martial law.
 - (2) The Governor, the department, a State agency, a board or commission, a county executive or a governing body of a municipality may not adopt or enforce a State law, an ordinance, a regulation, a rule or an order that mandates the vaccination of an individual at any time, including during the COVID-19 disaster emergency or any other state of disaster emergency or during a period of insurrection or martial law, as condition to receive any of the following:
 - (i) Government benefits.
- 22 (ii) Government services.
 - (iii) A government-issued license or permit.
- 24 (iv) Access to a public building.
- 25 (v) Access to public transportation.
- 26 (3) The Governor, the department, a State agency, a
 27 board or commission, a county executive or a governing body
 28 of a municipality may not provide any special privilege,
 29 financial benefit or other incentive to an individual for
 30 receiving a vaccination at any time, including during the

- 1 COVID-19 disaster emergency or any other state of disaster
- 2 emergency or during a period of insurrection or martial law.
- 3 Section 5. Vaccination without consent prohibited.
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person may not
- 5 administer a vaccination, an immunization, a genetic modulation
- 6 or an inoculation for an individual without the individual's
- 7 express consent or, if the individual is a minor or
- 8 incapacitated, without the express consent of the individual's
- 9 legal parent or guardian.
- 10 Section 6. Vaccination mandates by business entities and ticket
- issuers prohibited.
- 12 (a) Business entities. -- A business entity may not refuse to
- 13 provide any service, product, admission to a venue or
- 14 transportation to a person because the person has or has not
- 15 received a vaccination.
- 16 (b) Ticket issuers. -- A ticket issuer may not penalize a
- 17 ticket holder, discriminate against a ticket holder or deny
- 18 access to an entertainment event to a ticket holder because the
- 19 ticket holder has or has not received a vaccination.
- 20 (c) Penalties.--
- 21 (1) A business entity or ticket issuer that violates
- this section commits a felony of the third degree.
- 23 (2) Upon a finding of a violation under subsection (a),
- the appropriate licensing board or commission under the
- 25 Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs shall suspend
- the business entity's business license for no less than 30
- 27 days and no more than one year.
- 28 Section 7. Effective date.
- 29 This act shall take effect immediately.
