AN ACT

Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and 2 brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating and 3 changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession, 5 consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding 6 in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the 7 8 persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and 9 10 duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores, 11 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective 12 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain 13 nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure 14 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures; 15 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," in 16 licenses and regulations and liquor, alcohol and malt and 17 brewed beverages, further providing for rights of 18 19 municipalities preserved. 20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 21 hereby enacts as follows: 22 Section 1. Section 493.1(e)(1) and (2) of the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code, are amended 24 to read: 25 Section 493.1 Rights of Municipalities Preserved .--* * * 26

(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the

- 1 contrary, the holder of a [limited winery] license <u>under this</u>
- 2 <u>act</u> that is located in a class 2A through 8 county may use or
- 3 permit to be used inside or outside of the licensed premises a
- 4 loudspeaker or similar device whereby the sound of music or
- 5 other entertainment, or the advertisement thereof, does not
- 6 exceed 75 decibels beyond the licensee's property line.
- 7 (2) The provisions of [subsection (a)] paragraph (1) shall
- 8 only apply:
- 9 (i) From ten o'clock antemeridian until [eight] ten o'clock
- 10 postmeridian on every day except Fridays and Saturdays; and
- 11 (ii) From ten o'clock antemeridian until [ten] twelve
- 12 o'clock [postmeridian] antemeridian on Fridays or Saturdays.

- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
