## AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in bonds and 2 recognizances, further providing for bail to be governed by 3 general rules. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 5702 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 9 § 5702. Bail to be governed by general rules. 10 (a) General rule. -- Except as otherwise provided by this 11 title and the laws relating to the regulation of surety 12 companies, all matters relating to the fixing, posting, forfeiting, exoneration and distribution of bail and 13 14 recognizances shall be governed by general rules. 15 (b) Use of cash bail. --16 (1) In a case in which the defendant is the named 17 depositor, any cash bail deposited by the defendant which is 18 otherwise returnable to the defendant shall be held and applied to the payment of any restitution, fees, fines and 19

- 3 <u>the defendant would suffer an undue hardship.</u>
- 4 (2) In a case in which the defendant is not the named
- 5 <u>depositor</u>, the court may order, upon motion of the attorney
- for the Commonwealth, that any cash bail deposited on behalf
- 7 <u>of the defendant which is otherwise returnable to the</u>
- 8 <u>depositor be held and applied to the payment of any</u>
- 9 restitution, fees, fines and costs imposed upon the defendant
- in connection with a criminal or delinquency case unless the
- 11 <u>depositor shows that the depositer would suffer an undue</u>
- 12 <u>hardship.</u>
- 13 (c) Notice. -- Written notice of the provisions of subsection
- 14 (b) shall be provided to a depositor prior to the acceptance of
- 15 a deposit of cash bail.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
