## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12	Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), entitled "An act relating to insurance; amending, revising, and consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and supervision of insurance carried by such companies, associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and repealing existing laws," in casualty insurance, further providing for coverage for colorectal cancer screening.
13	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14	hereby enacts as follows:
15	Section 1. Section 635.3(a) of the act of May 17, 1921
16	(P.L.682, No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921,
17	is amended to read:
18	Section 635.3. Coverage for Colorectal Cancer Screening
19	(a) Except to the extent already covered under another policy,
20	all health insurance policies as defined in this section shall
21	also provide coverage for colorectal cancer screening for

covered individuals in accordance with American Cancer Society
 guidelines for colorectal cancer screening published as of
 [January 1, 2008] <u>May 30, 2018</u>, and consistent with approved
 medical standards and practices.

5 (1) Coverage for nonsymptomatic covered individuals who are
6 [fifty (50)] forty-five (45) years of age or older shall
7 include, but not be limited to:

8 (i) An annual fecal occult blood test.

9 (ii) A sigmoidoscopy, a screening barium enema or a test 10 consistent with approved medical standards and practices to 11 detect colon cancer, at least once every five (5) years.

12 (iii) A colonoscopy at least once every ten (10) years.
13 (2) Coverage for symptomatic covered individuals shall
14 include a colonoscopy, sigmoidoscopy or any combination of
15 colorectal cancer screening tests at a frequency determined by a
16 treating physician.

(3) Coverage for nonsymptomatic covered individuals who are at high or increased risk for colorectal cancer who are under [fifty (50)] forty-five (45) years of age shall include a colonoscopy or any combination of colorectal cancer screening tests in accordance with the American Cancer Society guidelines on screening for colorectal cancer published as of [January 1, 2008] May 30, 2018.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
