8	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
9	hereby enacts as follows:	
10	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated	
11	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:	
12	§ 7507.2. Confidentiality of personal information for public	<
13	safety officials.	
14	(a) General rule.	
15	(1) No person shall publicly post, publicly display or	
16	provide to a third party the home address or telephone number	<u> </u>
17	of any public safety official or of any public safety	
18	official's spouse or child knowing that the person is a	
19	public safety official and that a third party is only seeking	

Τ	<u>information because of the public safety official's</u>
2	occupation and may cause to harm or threaten to harm the
3	public safety official or the public safety official's spouse
4	or child.
5	(2) No person, business or association shall solicit,
6	sell or trade on the Internet the home address or telephone
7	number of a public safety official that may cause harm to the
8	public safety official or to any person residing at the
9	public safety official's home address.
10	<u>(b) Penalty.</u>
11	(1) A violation of subsection (a) is a misdemeanor of
12	the third degree, if there is no bodily injury of the public
13	safety official or the person's spouse or child.
14	(2) A violation of subsection (a) that leads to the
15	bodily injury of the public safety official or the person's
16	spouse or child is a misdemeanor of the first degree.
17	(c) Right to action.
18	(1) Notwithstanding any other law, a public safety
19	official whose home address or telephone number is solicited,
20	sold or traded in violation of this section may bring an
21	action in a court of competent jurisdiction.
22	(2) If a jury or court finds that a violation has
23	occurred, damages shall be awarded to the public safety
24	official in an amount up to a maximum of three times the
25	actual damages, but not less than \$2,000.
26	(d) Definitions. The following words and phrases when used
27	in this section shall have the meanings given to them in this
28	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
29	"Public safety official." An individual referred to in
30	section 2702(c) (relating to aggravated assault), except

- 1 paragraphs (22), (26), (33) and (36). The term includes any
- 2 person who is determined to be a law enforcement officer for
- 3 purposes of the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as
- 4 the Right to Know Law. The term excludes an individual who is a
- 5 <u>candidate for or holds an elective office.</u>
- 6 "Publicly display" and "publicly post." To intentionally
- 7 communicate or otherwise make available to the general public,
- 8 including on the Internet.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
- 10 § 2719. ENDANGERMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICIAL.
- 11 (A) ENDANGERMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICIAL. -- A PERSON
- 12 COMMITS THE OFFENSE OF ENDANGERING A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICIAL IF
- 13 THE PERSON INTENTIONALLY OR KNOWINGLY COMMUNICATES, OR PUBLISHES

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- 14 THROUGH AN ELECTRONIC SOCIAL MEDIA SERVICE, THE RESTRICTED
- 15 PERSONAL INFORMATION OF A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICIAL OR A FAMILY OR
- 16 HOUSEHOLD MEMBER OF A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICIAL WITH:
- 17 (1) RECKLESS DISREGARD THAT THE RESTRICTED PERSONAL
- 18 INFORMATION WILL BE USED TO THREATEN, INTIMIDATE OR
- 19 <u>FACILITATE THE COMMISSION OF A CRIME AGAINST THE PUBLIC</u>
- 20 SAFETY OFFICIAL OR A FAMILY OR HOUSEHOLD MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC
- 21 SAFETY OFFICIAL; OR
- 22 (2) THE INTENT THAT THE RESTRICTED PERSONAL INFORMATION
- 23 <u>WILL BE USED TO THREATEN, INTIMIDATE OR FACILITATE THE</u>
- 24 COMMISSION OF A CRIME AGAINST THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICIAL OR A
- 25 FAMILY OR HOUSEHOLD MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICIAL.
- 26 (B) GRADING.--
- 27 (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2), AN OFFENSE
- 28 UNDER SUBSECTION (A) SHALL CONSTITUTE A MISDEMEANOR OF THE
- 29 FIRST DEGREE.
- 30 (2) AN OFFENSE UNDER SUBSECTION (A) THAT RESULTS IN

- 1 BODILY INJURY TO A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICIAL OR A FAMILY OR
- 2 HOUSEHOLD MEMBER OF A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICIAL SHALL CONSTITUTE
- 3 A FELONY OF THE SECOND DEGREE.
- 4 (C) DEFINITIONS.--AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING
- 5 WORDS AND PHRASES SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS
- 6 SUBSECTION UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
- 7 "COMMUNICATE." CONVEY A MESSAGE BY ORAL, NONVERBAL, WRITTEN
- 8 OR ELECTRONIC MEANS, INCLUDING TELEPHONE, ELECTRONIC MAIL,
- 9 INTERNET, FACSIMILE, TELEX, WIRELESS COMMUNICATION OR SIMILAR
- 10 TRANSMISSION.
- 11 "FAMILY OR HOUSEHOLD MEMBER." SPOUSES OR PERSONS WHO HAVE
- 12 BEEN SPOUSES, PERSONS LIVING AS SPOUSES OR WHO LIVED AS SPOUSES,
- 13 PARENTS, CHILDREN, OTHER PERSONS RELATED BY CONSANGUINITY OR
- 14 AFFINITY, CURRENT OR FORMER SEXUAL OR INTIMATE PARTNERS OR
- 15 PERSONS WHO SHARE BIOLOGICAL PARENTHOOD.
- 16 "PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICIAL." AN INDIVIDUAL LISTED UNDER SECTION
- 17 2702(C) (RELATING TO AGGRAVATED ASSAULT).
- 18 "RESTRICTED PERSONAL INFORMATION." AN INDIVIDUAL'S IMAGE,
- 19 NAME, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, HOME ADDRESS, HOME PHONE NUMBER,
- 20 MOBILE PHONE NUMBER, PERSONAL EMAIL OR HOME FAX NUMBER.
- 21 SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 90 DAYS.
