12	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
13	hereby enacts as follows:
14	Section 1. Section 211 of the act of August 9, 1955
15	(P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, is amended by
16	adding a subsection to read:
17	Section 211. Ascertainment, Certification and Effect of
18	Change of Class* * *
19	(d) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, as
20	<u>a result of the delays in the 2020 Federal decennial census and </u>
21	the COVID-19 pandemic, the classification of all counties as of
22	the effective date of this subsection shall remain unchanged

1	until the 2030 census, at which time the procedures established
2	in subsections (a), (b) and (c) shall apply. For the purposes of
3	determining whether a county has decreased in population so as
4	to recede in classification under subsection (b) following the
5	2030 decennial census, both the 2020 and 2030 decennial censuses
6	shall be considered.
7	Section 2. Repeals are as follows:
8	(1) The General Assembly declares that the repeals under
9	paragraph (2) are necessary to effectuate the addition of
10	section 211(d).
11	(2) Sections 210 and 211 of the act of July 28, 1953
12	(P.L.723, No.230), known as the Second Class County Code, are
13	repealed.
14	Section 3. This act shall take effect September 30, 2021, or
15	immediately, whichever is later.
