7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
10	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
11	section to read:
12	<u>Section 1302.1. Military Child Advance Enrollment(a) A</u>
13	child whose parent or guardian is an active duty member of the
14	armed forces of the United States, including a reserve
15	component, may establish residency for purposes of section 1302
16	by providing to the school district a copy of the military order
17	requiring the parent's or guardian's transfer to a military
18	installation in the school district.
19	(b) A child who establishes residency under subsection (a)

- 1 must provide to the school district proof of residence in the
- 2 <u>district no later than ten (10) days after the arrival date</u>
- 3 <u>specified in the military order</u>.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
