Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, providing for military child advance enrollment. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 11 section to read: Section 1302.1. Military Child Advance Enrollment. -- (a) A- <--12 13 child whose parent or quardian is an active duty member of the 14 armed forces of the United States, including a reserve 15 component, may establish residency for 16 by providing to the -school distri 17 requiring the parent's or quardian's transfer 18 installation in the school district. LEGAL GUARDIAN IS AN ACTIVE DUTY MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES OF

- 1 THE UNITED STATES, INCLUDING A RESERVE COMPONENT, AND HAS
- 2 RECEIVED OFFICIAL MILITARY ORDERS TO TRANSFER INTO OR WITHIN
- 3 THIS COMMONWEALTH SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO ESTABLISH RESIDENCY FOR
- 4 PURPOSES OF SECTION 1302 IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT IN WHICH THE
- 5 CHILD WILL BE RESIDING, UPON PROVIDING A COPY OF THE OFFICIAL
- 6 MILITARY ORDERS TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT.
- 7 (B) THE RECEIVING SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL ENROLL A CHILD WHO
- 8 ESTABLISHES RESIDENCY UNDER SUBSECTION (A) AT LEAST ONE BUSINESS
- 9 DAY BEFORE THE ARRIVAL DATE SPECIFIED IN THE MILITARY ORDER.
- 10 (C) A child who establishes residency under subsection <--
- 11 (a) must provide to the school district proof of residence in
- 12 the district no later than ten (10) days after the arrival date
- 13 specified in the military order.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
