AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 7 8 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation 17 18 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of 19 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be 20 21 determined," in temporary regulatory flexibility authority, further providing for definitions and for temporary 22 regulatory flexibility authority. 23 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 25 hereby enacts as follows: 26 Section 1. The definition of "order" in section 2101-F of 27 the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, added June 11, 2021 (P.L.56, 28
- 29 No.21), is amended to read:

- 2 The following words and phrases when used in this article
- 3 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 4 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 5 * * *
- 6 ["Order."] "COVID-19 declaration of disaster emergency." Any
- 7 of the following:
- 8 (1) the declaration of disaster emergency issued by the
- 9 Governor on March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March
- 10 21, 2020); or
- 11 (2) a declaration of disaster emergency relating to
- 12 COVID-19 which is issued after March 6, 2020.
- 13 Section 2. Section 2102-F(a) and (b) of the act, added June
- 14 11, 2021 (P.L.56, No.21), are amended and the section is amended
- 15 by adding a subsection to read:
- 16 Section 2102-F. Temporary regulatory flexibility authority.
- 17 (a) Extension. -- The suspension of a regulatory statute
- 18 prescribing the procedures for conduct of Commonwealth business,
- 19 or an order, rule or regulation of a Commonwealth agency which
- 20 was suspended under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(f)(1) (relating to general
- 21 authority of Governor) as of the last day that the [order]
- 22 <u>COVID-19 declaration of disaster emergency</u>, as amended and
- 23 renewed, was in effect is extended until September 30, 2021,
- 24 unless sooner terminated by the authority which initially
- 25 authorized the suspension.
- 26 (b) Applicability. -- A suspension which is extended under
- 27 subsection (a) shall be retroactive to the last day that the
- 28 [order] <u>COVID-19 declaration of disaster emergency</u>, as amended
- 29 and renewed, was in effect.

- 1 (d) Final report. -- No later than November 1, 2021, each
- 2 authority which initially authorized a suspension which was
- 3 <u>extended under subsection (a) shall issue a final report. A</u>
- 4 <u>final report under this subsection shall include all of the</u>
- 5 following:
- 6 (1) A list of each suspension which was extended under
- 7 subsection (a). The list under this paragraph shall include a
- 8 <u>reference to the statute, order, rule or regulation which was</u>
- 9 <u>suspended.</u>
- 10 (2) For each suspension under paragraph (1) which was
- terminated under subsection (a), the date that the suspension
- 12 was terminated.
- 13 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
