AN ACT

1 Amending the act of December 20, 1985 (P.L.457, No.112),
2 entitled "An act relating to the right to practice medicine
3 and surgery and the right to practice medically related acts;
4 reestablishing the State Board of Medical Education and
5 Licensure as the State Board of Medicine and providing for
6 its composition, powers and duties; providing for the
7 issuance of licenses and certificates and the suspension and
8 revocation of licenses and certificates; provided penalties;
9 and making repeals," further providing for institutional
10 license; and abrogating a related regulation.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 Section 1. Section 32 of the act of December 20, 1985
14 (P.L.457, No.112), known as the Medical Practice Act of 1985, is
15 amended by adding a subsection to read:

16 Section 32. Institutional license.

17 * * *

18 (d) Authorization.--Notwithstanding 49 Pa. Code § 17.3(d)
19 (relating to institutional license), a licensee may practice at
20 more than two affiliated facilities when practicing or teaching
21 under an institutional license.

1 Section 2. The provisions of 49 Pa. Code § 17.3(d) are
2 abrogated insofar as they are inconsistent with the addition of
3 section 32(d) of the act.

4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
