AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and 17 prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation 18 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of 19 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be 20 determined," in United States Semiguincentennial, providing 21 for infrastructure improvements and projects. 22
- 23 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 24 hereby enacts as follows:
- 25 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known

- 1 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a
- 2 section to read:
- 3 <u>Section 2808.1-I. Infrastructure improvements and projects.</u>
- 4 (a) Committee. -- A committee is established within the
- 5 commission to review and select infrastructure improvements and
- 6 projects under section 2807-I(2).
- 7 <u>(b) Membership.--The following shall apply:</u>
- 8 (1) The committee shall consist of the following
- 9 <u>members:</u>
- 10 (i) Ten members of the Senate, of whom:
- 11 (A) Five shall be appointed by the Majority
- 12 Leader of the Senate.
- (B) Five shall be appointed by the Minority
- 14 <u>Leader of the Senate.</u>
- 15 (ii) Ten members of the House of Representatives, of
- 16 whom:
- 17 (A) Five shall be appointed by the Speaker of
- the House of Representatives.
- 19 (B) Five shall be appointed by the Minority
- Leader of the House of Representatives.
- 21 (2) To the extent possible, each member under paragraph
- 22 (1) shall be chosen in accordance with the following
- 23 guidelines:
- (i) one member from each political party from the
- 25 southeastern region;
- 26 (ii) one member from each political party from the
- 27 northeastern region;
- 28 (iii) one member from each political party from the
- Northern Tier or central region;
- 30 (iv) one member from each political party from the

1	northwestern region; and
2	(v) one member from each political party from the
3	western or southwestern region.
4	(3) Section 2814-I shall apply to members of the
5	committee.
6	(c) Selection process The committee shall:
7	(1) Meet within 30 days of the effective date of this
8	section to schedule a series of meetings and hearings in each
9	geographic region.
10	(2) Choose infrastructure improvements and projects in
11	each region that shall be completed by January 31, 2026. The
12	following shall apply:
13	(i) Each infrastructure improvement or project shall
14	be a legacy project that allows each region to secure
15	funding for one or multiple improvements or projects that
16	help the region welcome the rest of the nation and the
17	world to this Commonwealth during the United States
18	Semiquincentennial.
19	(ii) The committee shall approve infrastructure
20	improvements and projects that have a lasting legacy for
21	future generations of Pennsylvanians.
22	(3) Consider infrastructure improvements and projects
23	that will be funded by Federal infrastructure dollars.
24	(4) Complete the selection of infrastructure
25	improvements and projects by December 31, 2022.
26	(5) Inform the public of merit-worthy infrastructure
27	improvements and projects through a series of public
28	hearings, with at least two public hearings in each region.
29	The hearings shall provide an opportunity for stakeholders,
30	including nonprofit organizations, art and history

- 1 <u>organizations, religious leaders, elected officials, civic</u>
- 2 leaders and members of the community, to identify
- 3 infrastructure improvements and projects that will best
- 4 position the region for the United States Semiquincentennial.
- 5 (6) For purposes of this subsection, the term
- 6 <u>"geographic region" means a region of this Commonwealth in</u>
- 7 which members are selected under subsection (b) (2).
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
