AN ACT

Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in Adjutant General, further providing for general powers and duties of Adjutant General; and, in 2 3 State Veterans' Commission and Deputy Adjutant General for Veterans' Affairs, further providing for qualifications and 5 status and for specific duties. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 902(10) of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania 9 10 Consolidated Statutes is repealed: 11 § 902. General powers and duties of Adjutant General. 12 The Adjutant General as head of the department is responsible 13 to the Commonwealth and to the Governor for the organization and 14 functioning of said department, and the performance and carrying 15 out of all the duties, powers and responsibilities given or 16 delegated. In addition he is hereby authorized and directed to: * * * 17 Make such bylaws, rules and regulations for the 18 management, general direction and control of the property of 19

- 4 Section 2. Sections 1711 and 1712 of Title 51 are amended to
- 5 read:
- 6 § 1711. Qualifications and status.
- 7 (a) [Deputy Adjutants General.--] Office of Deputy Adjutant_
- 8 <u>General for Veterans' Affairs. -- The Office of Deputy Adjutant</u>
- 9 <u>General for Veterans' Affairs is established within the</u>
- 10 <u>department for administrative purposes only and shall report to</u>
- 11 the Governor on all matters concerning veterans and their
- 12 <u>families in this Commonwealth and shall work in consultation</u>
- 13 <u>with the advisory board.</u> In addition to such other Deputy
- 14 Adjutants General as may be named in the department, there shall
- 15 be a Deputy Adjutant General for Veterans' Affairs, who shall
- 16 perform the duties under section 1712 (relating to specific
- 17 duties) [and such other duties as the Adjutant General may
- 18 assign].
- 19 (b) Appointment. -- The Deputy Adjutant General for Veterans'
- 20 Affairs shall be [selected and appointed as other Deputy
- 21 Adjutants General are selected and appointed. He shall be a
- 22 veteran and an active member of at least one of the veterans'
- 23 organizations listed under section 1702(b) (relating to State
- 24 Veterans' Commission).] appointed by the Governor from the list
- 25 of applicants provided by the advisory board.
- 26 (c) Compensation. -- The compensation of the Deputy Adjutant
- 27 General for Veterans' Affairs shall be as established by law.
- 28 (d) Status. -- [The Deputy Adjutant General for Veterans'
- 29 Affairs shall be accorded all the rights, emoluments and
- 30 privileges, except pay and allowances, of a brigadier general in

- 1 the Pennsylvania Guard and shall be addressed as "General."] The
- 2 <u>qualifications of the Deputy Adjutant General for Veterans'</u>
- 3 Affairs shall be as follows:
- 4 (1) Must be a veteran with at least eight years of
- 5 <u>service in the armed forces of the United States, which shall</u>
- 6 <u>include service in a reserve component or National Guard, and</u>
- 7 <u>discharged or released from service under honorable</u>
- 8 conditions.
- 9 (2) Must possess a current and valid license related to
- the administration of a nursing home, personal care home or
- 11 long-term care facility.
- 12 (3) Must have at least a four-year degree in business or
- 13 <u>administration</u>.
- 14 (4) Must possess a current and valid certification or
- 15 <u>license at or above a paramedic or advanced emergency medical</u>
- 16 technician.
- 17 (5) Must have acquired consecutively not less than two
- 18 years' experience in an administrative capacity.
- 19 § 1712. Specific duties.
- In addition to such other duties as may be provided by law or
- 21 as assigned by the [Adjutant General] Governor, the Deputy
- 22 Adjutant General for Veterans' Affairs shall have the following
- 23 specific duties:
- 24 (1) To recommend to [the Adjutant General and] the
- Governor, with the advice of the [State Veterans' Commission]
- 26 commission and the advisory board, new legislation and
- amendments to existing statutes concerning veterans and their
- 28 activities for consideration by the General Assembly.
- 29 (2) To cooperate with all Federal and State departments
- and agencies in the interest of veterans.

- 1 (3) To aid in filing and prosecuting claims of
 2 Pennsylvania's veterans and their dependents under Federal or
 3 State laws or regulations.
- 4 (4) To aid veterans in seeking employment or

 5 reemployment after their [honorable discharge from] service

 6 in the armed forces of the United States[.], including a

 7 reserve component or National Guard, in which their discharge

 8 or release from service was under conditions other than

 9 dishonorable.
 - (5) To aid veterans requiring medical care in securing hospitalization provided by a Federal or State [medical or care] health care facility.
 - (6) To aid in the rehabilitation of injured, wounded or compensable veterans in educational institutions or vocational training institutions for which they may be eligible by law.
 - (7) To cooperate with and advise the Department of Education with respect to vocational training programs for veterans and their dependents, particularly programs suited to casualties.
 - (8) To administer relief provided by the Commonwealth for veterans and their dependents.
- 23 (9) To administer the distribution [under the direction of the Adjutant General] of any compensation to veterans or their dependents that has been or may be granted by the Commonwealth.
- 27 (10) To investigate <u>and report to the Governor and the</u>
 28 <u>commission</u> the work of other State agencies in administering
 29 laws affecting veterans and their dependents.
- 30 (11) To investigate, compile and maintain complete and

- 1 accurate data concerning veterans of the armed forces of the
- 2 United States, including a reserve component or National
- 3 <u>Guard</u>, and all State and municipal activities related
- 4 thereto.
- 5 (12) To compile from the records transmitted from the 6 various counties of this Commonwealth a record of the burial 7 places in this Commonwealth of deceased veterans, including 8 such information as the Deputy Adjutant General for Veterans' 9 Affairs or his designee deems necessary and appropriate.
- 10 (13) To disseminate information concerning
 11 Pennsylvania's veterans and Pennsylvania's veterans' programs
 12 to the advisory board, to veterans' organizations, to the
 13 public press and other media and to the general public.
- 14 (14) To biannually submit, through the Adjutant General,
 15 to the Governor <u>and the advisory board</u> a report of State
 16 activities on behalf of veterans.
- 17 (15) To serve as a clearinghouse for all problems or
 18 issues related to Pennsylvania's veterans and their
 19 dependents.
- 20 (16) To serve as Executive Secretary of the [State 21 Veterans' Commission] commission.
- 22 (17) To appoint, in consultation with the advisory
- board, the commandant of a veterans' home.
- 24 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
