AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for
3 application for registration and for issuance of registration
4 card.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Sections 1305(a) and 1308(a) of Title 75 of the
8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:

9 § 1305. Application for registration.

10 (a) General rule.--Application for the registration of a
11 vehicle shall be made to the department upon the appropriate
12 form or forms furnished by the department. The application shall
13 contain the full name and address of the owner or owners[;], the
14 make, model, year and vehicle identification number of the
15 vehicle[;], the fuel type and designation of fuel, liquid fuel
16 or alternative fuel and such other information as the department
17 may require. Program participants in the Address Confidentiality
18 Program under 23 Pa.C.S. Ch. 67 (relating to domestic and sexual
19 violence victim address confidentiality) may use a substitute

1 address designated by the Office of Victim Advocate as their
2 address. Applicants for registration of a truck, truck tractor,
3 trailer or bus shall provide the vehicle's Gross Vehicle Weight
4 Rating (GVWR), or the Gross Combination Weight Rating (GCWR), as
5 applicable. If the manufacturer's ratings are not available, the
6 applicant shall provide sufficient information as to the
7 horsepower, braking capacity and such other data as necessary
8 for the department to determine an equivalent measure of the
9 vehicle's hauling and stopping capability. If the applicant
10 wishes to register a vehicle at a registered gross weight less
11 than the gross vehicle weight rating, the application shall
12 include information as to weight, load and any other such
13 information as the department may require. The application shall
14 be accompanied by self-certification of financial responsibility
15 and the applicable fee.

17 § 1308. Issuance of registration card.

18 (a) General rule.--The department, upon registering a
19 vehicle, shall issue to the registrant a registration card which
20 shall contain the registration number assigned to the vehicle,
21 the name and address of the registrant and the name of the
22 owner, if other than the registrant, a description of the
23 vehicle including the vehicle identification number, the
24 expiration date, the fuel type and designation of fuel, liquid
25 fuel or alternative fuel and such other information as may be
26 determined by the department.

28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
