AN ACT

Amending Title 74 (Transportation) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in turnpike, further providing for 2 electronic toll collection. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 8117 of Title 74 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 8117. Electronic toll collection. 8 * * * 9 10 (d.1) Notice for malfunctioning electronic toll collection 11 devices .--(1) If the commission is unable to collect a toll from a 12 13 toll collection account holder due to a malfunctioning or 14 unreadable electronic toll collection device, the commission 15 shall send a notice, in a manner as required by paragraph 16 (2), to the account holder of the malfunctioning or unreadable electronic toll collection device. The notice 17 shall contain all of the following: 18

1	(i) The date on which the toll was unable to be
2	collected due to the malfunctioning or unreadable
3	electronic toll collection device.
4	(ii) Solutions to address common causes of a
5	malfunctioning or unreadable electronic toll collection
6	device and instructions to replace an electronic toll
7	collection device.
8	(iii) A warning that the commission may impose a fee
9	for the toll that was unable to be collected from the
10	account holder due to the malfunctioning or unreadable
11	electronic toll collection device, whether the fee is
12	being imposed and the fee amount.
13	(iv) Other information at the discretion of the
14	commission.
15	(2) The notice required under paragraph (1) shall be
16	sent by the commission to the account holder's electronic
17	mail address that was provided by the account holder for the
18	establishment of the electronic toll collection account. The
19	notice shall be sent within 24 hours of the date on which the
20	uncollected toll occurred.
21	(3) The commission is prohibited from imposing a fee for
22	a toll that was unable to be collected from an account holder
23	due to a malfunctioning or unreadable electronic toll
24	collection device unless the notice requirements of this
25	subsection are met.
26	(4) If the commission attempts to send a notice required
27	by this subsection to an electronic mail address provided by
28	an account holder and determines that the electronic mail
29	address is not valid or is undeliverable, the commission
30	shall be considered to have met the notice requirements of

- 1 <u>this subsection.</u>

- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
