## AN ACT

- Amending Title 44 (Law and Justice) of the Pennsylvania
  Consolidated Statutes, providing for reduction of local
  police services.

  The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
  hereby enacts as follows:
  Section 1. Title 44 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated

  Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

- 16 This chapter relates to reduction of local police services.
- 17 § 2502. Definitions.
- 18 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 19 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

- 1 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 2 <u>"State Police." The Pennsylvania State Police.</u>
- 3 § 2503. Fee for reduction of local police services.
- 4 (a) Reduction of local police services. -- In any given year,
- 5 <u>a municipality that reduces the municipality's budget allocation</u>
- 6 for police services by 25% or more from the prior calendar year
- 7 <u>must pay to the Commonwealth an amount equal to the reduction in</u>
- 8 the municipality's budget allocation for police services.
- 9 (b) Elimination of local police services. -- In any given
- 10 year, a municipality that eliminates the municipality's police
- 11 <u>services from the prior calendar year must pay to the</u>
- 12 Commonwealth an amount equal to the municipality's most recent
- 13 police budget allocation.
- 14 (c) Regulations.--Regulations under the act of July 10, 1987
- 15 (P.L.246, No.47), known as the Municipalities Financial Recovery
- 16 Act, shall apply to municipalities classified as distressed.
- 17 § 2504. Allocation of money.
- 18 Money collected under section 2503 (relating to fee for
- 19 reduction of local police services) shall be deposited into the
- 20 General Fund and shall be used exclusively to defray the cost of
- 21 State Police operations.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022, or
- 23 immediately, whichever is later.
