6	Section 1. Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

4	<u>§ 2001. Definitions.</u>
5	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
6	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
7	context clearly indicates otherwise:
8	"Commission." The Veterans' Suicide Memorial Commission.
9	<u>§ 2002. Establishment.</u>
10	The Veterans' Suicide Memorial Commission is established to
11	develop plans to erect, on the grounds of the Indiantown Gap
12	National Cemetery, a memorial in honor and memory of
13	Pennsylvania veterans who have died by suicide.
14	§ 2003. Composition.
15	The commission shall be composed of the following:
16	(1) The Adjutant General, who shall be the chairperson
17	of the commission.
18	(2) The Secretary of Human Services.
19	(3) The Executive Director of the Pennsylvania
20	Historical and Museum Commission.
21	(4) A member of a veterans' organization, appointed by
22	<u>the Adjutant General.</u>
23	(5) A member of the Senate, appointed by the President
24	pro tempore of the Senate.
25	(6) A member of the Senate, appointed by the Minority
26	Leader of the Senate.
27	(7) A member of the House of Representatives, appointed
28	by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
29	(8) A member of the House of Representatives, appointed
30	by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.
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1	§ 2004. Vacancies.
2	Vacancies in the membership of the commission shall be filled
3	in the same manner as the original appointment.
4	<u>§ 2005. Expenses.</u>
5	Commission members may not receive compensation for their
6	services, but shall be reimbursed by the department for all
7	necessary travel and other reasonable expenses incurred in
8	connection with the performance of their duties as members of
9	the commission.
10	<u>§ 2006. Administrative services.</u>
11	The department shall provide administrative staff, support
12	and services to the commission on an ongoing basis.
13	<u>§ 2007. Duties.</u>
14	The commission shall have the following powers and duties:
15	(1) To develop detailed plans, including site, size and
16	costs, relevant to the creation of a Veterans' Suicide
17	Memorial.
18	(2) To submit a written report of its findings,
19	recommendations and proposals for necessary legislation to
20	effectuate the erection of a Veterans' Suicide Memorial to
21	the General Assembly.
22	<u>§ 2008. Expiration.</u>
23	This chapter shall expire upon the submission of the report
24	by the commission to the General Assembly under section 2007
25	(relating to duties).
