AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in assault, providing for the offense
3 of unauthorized location tracking.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 2709.2. Unauthorized location tracking.

9 (a) Offense defined.--A person commits the crime of
10 unauthorized location tracking when the person uses a
11 technological device to determine or monitor the location or
12 movement of another person or another person's property, without
13 the prior authorization of the other person or, if the other
14 person is under 18 years of age, the other person's parent or
15 legal guardian.

16 (b) Venue.--An offense committed under this section may be

1 deemed to have been committed where:

2 (1) the information was received;

3 (2) the victim resides; or

4 (3) the property is located.

5 (c) Grading.--A violation of this section shall constitute a

6 misdemeanor of the third degree.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
