AN ACT

- Amending the act of November 26, 1978 (P.L.1375, No.325),
 entitled "An act providing for the regulation and safety of
 dams and reservoirs, water obstructions and encroachments;
 consolidating and clarifying the programs of the Department
 of Environmental Resources and Navigation Commission for the
 Delaware River; establishing penalties and repealing certain
 acts," further providing for definitions; and providing for
 small stream maintenance project permit.
- 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- 11 Section 1. Section 3 of the act of November 26, 1978
- 12 (P.L.1375, No.325), known as the Dam Safety and Encroachments
- 13 Act, is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 14 Section 3. Definitions.
- 15 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 16 have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
- 17 meanings given to them in this section:
- 18 * * *
- 19 "Flood-related hazard." Flood debris or similar obstruction
- 20 which may present a potential substantial risk to life or

- 1 property or may create additional problems in the event of
- 2 flooding.
- 3 * * *
- 4 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 5 <u>Section 6.1. Small stream maintenance project permit.</u>
- 6 (a) The department shall establish and authorize a small
- 7 stream maintenance project permit for mitigation of flood-
- 8 <u>related hazards of less than 250 linear feet or an area of less</u>
- 9 than one acre in size.
- 10 (b) The department shall delegate permit review and approval
- 11 <u>responsibilities to county conservation districts.</u>
- 12 (c) (1) An application for a small stream maintenance
- 13 project permit shall include:
- 14 <u>(i) A description of the small stream maintenance</u>
- 15 project.
- 16 <u>(ii) The location and area of the proposed project.</u>
- 17 (iii) A stream profile for a reasonable distance
- 18 upstream and downstream of the proposed project, showing
- 19 normal water surface and depths.
- 20 (iv) A description of the equipment to be used.
- 21 (v) Written approval from any affected property
- 22 owners, proof of title or easements for lands included in
- 23 <u>the proposed project site, as necessary.</u>
- 24 (vi) Any additional information the department deems
- 25 necessary.
- 26 (2) The department may not require an applicant specify
- 27 professional engineering services or similar professional
- 28 qualifications as provided under section 10 for the removal
- 29 of flood-related hazards or stream clearing activities under
- 30 a proposed project.

- 1 (d) A county conservation district shall grant a permit if
- 2 the county conservation district determines that the proposed
- 3 project complies with the provisions of this act and the
- 4 regulations promulgated under this act, and complies with all
- 5 other applicable laws administered by the department.
- 6 (e) No fees may be required for a small stream maintenance
- 7 project permit.
- 8 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
