- 1 Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in changes in records, further providing for death
- of registrant.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1505(b) of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1505. Death of registrant.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (b) Other sources.--<u>A commission may utilize information</u>
- 11 <u>obtained from the department through another source of official</u>
- 12 <u>data on registered electors reported dead, such as the</u>
- 13 Electronic Registration Information Center or similar data
- 14 <u>sources.</u> A commission may also utilize published newspaper
- 15 obituaries, letters testamentary or letters of administration
- 16 issued by the office of the registrar of wills to cancel and
- 17 remove the registration of an elector, provided that such
- 18 removals are uniform, nondiscriminatory and in compliance with
- 19 the Voting Rights Act of 1965 (Public Law 89-110, 42 U.S.C. §

- 1 1973 et seq.). The commission shall promptly update information
- 2 contained in its registration records.

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
