- 1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in service and facilities, further
- providing for notices before service to landlord terminated.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1523 of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 1523. Notices before service to landlord terminated.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (d) Rights of landlords.--Before any termination of service
- 11 to a landlord who has notified a public utility in writing of
- 12 the landlord's ownership interest in a property served by the
- 13 public utility, the public utility shall provide written notice
- 14 to the landlord of the proposed termination via first class mail
- 15 at least 37 days before the date of termination of service. If
- 16 the originating cause of the proposed termination of service is
- 17 not resolved, the public utility shall provide a final written
- 18 notice under this subsection via first class mail to the

- 1 <u>landlord at least 10 days before the proposed termination date.</u>
- 2 This subsection shall not apply to a landlord ratepayer.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
