## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public 2 welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance, 3 repealing provisions relating to expenditure of public funds 4 for abortions limited. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 453 of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, 8 9 No.21), known as the Human Services Code, is repealed: 10 [Section 453. Expenditure of Public Funds for Abortions Limited. -- Since it is the public policy of the Commonwealth to 11 favor childbirth over abortion, no Commonwealth funds and no 12 13 Federal funds which are appropriated by the Commonwealth shall 14 be expended by any State or local government agency for the 15 performance of abortion: Provided, That nothing in this act 16 shall be construed to deny the use of funds where a physician

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
