## AN ACT

1	Amending the act of June 27, 1996 (P.L.403, No.58), entitled "An

5	of Commerce to the Department of Community and Economic
6	Development; transferring functions of the Department of
7	Community Affairs into the Department of Community and
8	Economic Development and other agencies; providing for a
9	Deputy Secretary for Community Affairs and Development in the
10	Department of Community and Economic Development;
11	establishing the Center for Local Government Services and the
12	Local Government Advisory Committee; establishing the Small
13	Business Advocacy Council; conferring powers and duties on
14	the Legislative Reference Bureau; and making repeals," in
15	transfers of functions, transferring functions, duties and
16	entities to Department of Community and Economic Development;
17	in restructuring of certain administrative entities,
18	providing for State Apprenticeship and Training Council; and,
19	in restructuring of certain memberships and participation,
20	providing for membership on State Apprenticeship and Training
21	Council.

- 1 (a) Transfers from Department of Labor and Industry. -- The
- 2 following functions, duties and entities of the Department of
- 3 Labor and Industry shall be transferred to the department:
- 4 (1) The duties of the Commonwealth under sections 126,
- 5 <u>127, 128 and 129 of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity</u>
- 6 <u>Act (Public Law 113-128, 29 U.S.C. § 3161 et seq.).</u>
- 7 (2) The duties of the Commonwealth under sections 131,
- 8 132, 133 and 134 of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity
- 9 <u>Act (29 U.S.C. § 3171 et seq.).</u>
- 10 (3) The duties of the Commonwealth under sections 1, 2,
- 11 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 of the Wagner-Peyser
- 12 Act (48 Stat. 113, 29 U.S.C. §§ 49, 49a, 49b, 49c, 49d, 49e,

- 2 (b) Transfers from Department of Human Services.--The
- 3 following functions, duties and entities of the Department of
- 4 <u>Human Services shall be transferred to the department:</u>
- 5 (1) Employment and training programs funded under Part A
- of Title IV of the Personal Responsibility and Work
- 7 Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (Public Law 104-193,

- 12 (3) The program established under section 405.1B of the
- act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human
- 14 Services Code.
- 15 (c) Functions to be consolidated. -- The functions transferred
- 16 to the department under subsections (a) and (b) shall be
- 17 consolidated with similar functions of the department within the
- 18 department into the division, section or other organizational
- 19 <u>entity devoted to workforce development. The Governor shall</u>
- 20 appoint a Deputy Secretary for Workforce Development. The deputy
- 21 secretary shall have the powers and perform the functions and
- 22 duties transferred to the department under subsections (a) and
- 23 (b) and other such functions and duties authorized by the
- 24 Governor.
- 25 (d) Office of Vocational Rehabilitation. -- The department and
- 26 the Department of Labor and Industry shall enter into a
- 27 memorandum of understanding under which the services provided
- 28 under Title I of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Public Law 93-
- 29 112, 29 U.S.C. § 701 et seq.), other than section 112 of the
- 30 Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. § 732) or Part C of the

- 1 Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. § 741) that relate to
- 2 vocational rehabilitation services are, to the maximum extent
- 3 practicable, provided by the department.
- 4 (e) Documentation required for Federal programs. -- The
- 5 <u>department shall provide any necessary data, documentation or</u>
- 6 <u>verification needed by the Department of Labor and Industry or</u>
- 7 the Department of Human Services which may be necessary to
- 8 <u>effectuate the transfers under subsections (a) and (b).</u>
- 9 <u>Section 903. State Apprenticeship and Training Council.</u>
- 10 The State Apprenticeship and Training Council as provided for
- 11 <u>in section 3 of the act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.604, No.304),</u>
- 12 known as The Apprenticeship and Training Act, is hereby placed
- 13 and made a departmental board in the Department of Community and
- 14 <u>Economic Development.</u>
- 15 <u>Section 1111. Membership on State Apprenticeship and Training</u>
- 16 <u>Council.</u>
- 17 In place of the membership of the Deputy Secretary of the
- 18 Department of Labor and Industry on the State Apprenticeship and
- 19 Training Council under section 3 of the act of July 14, 1961
- 20 (P.L.604, No.304), known as The Apprenticeship and Training Act,
- 21 the Deputy Secretary for Workforce Development shall serve as an
- 22 ex officio member of the council but shall not be entitled to
- 23 vote, except that in the event of a tie vote, the Deputy
- 24 Secretary for Workforce Development shall have the right to cast
- 25 the tie-breaking vote.
- 26 Section 2. Section 3 of the act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.604,
- 27 No.304), known as The Apprenticeship and Training Act, is
- 28 repealed to the extent that it is inconsistent with this act.
- 29 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
