AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), entitled "An act to promote the public health and safety by providing for examination, licensing and granting of permits for those who 3 desire to engage in the profession of cosmetology; defining 4 cosmetology, and regulating cosmetology salons, schools, 5 students, apprentices, teachers, managers, manicurists and 6 cosmetologists; conferring powers and duties upon the Commissioner of Professional and Occupational Affairs of the 7 8 Department of State; providing for appeals to certain courts 9 by applicants and licensees; and providing penalties," 10 providing for salon area requirements and further providing 11 for temporary licenses. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. The act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), referred 16 to as the Cosmetology Law, is amended by adding a section to 17 read: 18 Section 9.4. Salon Area Requirements. -- (a) Except as provided under subsection (b), for a licensed cosmetology salon 19 20 operated by one licensee, the floor area of the salon shall be a 21 minimum of one hundred twenty square feet with a minimum width 22 of ten feet. If a salon under this subsection is operated by
- 23 more than one licensee, the floor area of the salon shall

- 1 <u>contain an additional sixty square feet for each additional</u>
- 2 <u>licensee</u>. The board, upon an applicant's request, may exempt a
- 3 salon from the floor area requirements under this subsection if
- 4 the board deems the exemption reasonable.
- 5 (b) For a licensed cosmetology salon that opened before
- 6 September 15, 1976, and is operated by one licensee, the floor
- 7 area of the salon shall contain sufficient space to properly
- 8 <u>install the necessary equipment to ensure the health and safety</u>
- 9 of the customers of the salon. The floor space of a salon under
- 10 this subsection shall be a minimum of ten feet by twelve feet or
- 11 one hundred twenty square feet. If a salon under this subsection
- 12 is operated by more than one licensee, the floor area of the
- 13 <u>salon shall contain an additional sixty square feet for each</u>
- 14 <u>additional licensee. The board, after examination of a salon's</u>
- 15 layout, may exempt the salon from the floor area requirements
- 16 under this subsection if the board deems the exemption
- 17 reasonable.
- 18 Section 2. Section 12.1 of the act is amended to read:
- 19 Section 12.1. Temporary Licenses. -- (a) Upon payment of the
- 20 required fee, a temporary license may be issued to any applicant
- 21 who is eliqible for admission to a cosmetologist's examination
- 22 or to the examination for any of the limited licenses. An
- 23 applicant who is thus licensed shall practice only under the
- 24 supervision of a licensed teacher or cosmetologist, or under the
- 25 supervision of the holder of a corresponding limited license,
- 26 until the time of the next scheduled examination. Temporary
- 27 licenses are granted for a nine-month period.
- 28 (b) Upon payment of a fee set by the board not to exceed one
- 29 <u>hundred dollars (\$100.00), a temporary salon license may be</u>
- 30 issued to a licensed cosmetologist who has submitted an

- 1 application for an initial license to operate a cosmetology
- 2 <u>salon</u>. A temporary salon license issued under this subsection
- 3 shall only be valid for a period of ninety days. To be eligible
- 4 for a temporary salon license under this subsection, the
- 5 <u>licensed cosmetologist shall certify all of the following to the</u>
- 6 board:
- 7 (1) The licensed cosmetologist has practiced cosmetology for
- 8 no less than three years prior to submitting the application for
- 9 <u>an initial license to operate a cosmetology salon.</u>
- 10 (2) The licensed cosmetologist will not employ any other
- 11 <u>individual at the salon while operating under the temporary</u>
- 12 <u>salon license.</u>
- 13 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
