AN ACT

- 1 Prohibiting enforcement of covenants not to compete in employment agreements.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Freedom to
- 7 Work Act.
- 8 Section 2. Declaration of policy.
- 9 The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
- 10 (1) The Commonwealth has a strong interest in applying
- its laws and protecting its businesses so they can hire the
- 12 employees of their choosing.
- 13 (2) The Commonwealth has a strong interest in lowering
- 14 the unemployment rate and providing individuals with every
- opportunity to make a living wage and maximize their talents
- 16 to provide for their family.
- 17 (3) The Commonwealth has a strong interest in promoting
- increased wages and benefits for working families.

- 1 (4) The Commonwealth has a strong interest in promoting
- 2 innovation, entrepreneurship, business expansion and
- 3 improving existing business opportunities to attract the best
- 4 qualified worker for open positions.
- 5 (5) The Commonwealth has a strong interest in promoting
- 6 unrestricted trade and mobility of employees in the work
- 7 force as well as promoting businesses' abilities to seek the
- 8 best qualified candidates for employment.
- 9 (6) The Commonwealth has a strong interest in workers
- 10 with high skill levels to increase their income and benefits.
- 11 (7) The Commonwealth has a strong interest in attracting
- major multinational high-tech companies to this Commonwealth
- 13 who plan to invest billions of dollars and hire tens of
- thousands of employees in high-paying jobs.
- 15 (8) The Commonwealth disfavors workers being forced to
- decide between staying in jobs they are overqualified for or
- 17 leaving the State for better opportunities.
- 18 (9) The Commonwealth has a strong interest in providing
- its residents with the tools needed to stay in Pennsylvania
- 20 to live, work and raise families.
- 21 Section 3. Definitions.
- The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 23 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 24 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Covenant not to compete." An agreement between an employer
- 26 and employee that is designed to impede the ability of the
- 27 employee to seek employment with another employer.
- 28 Section 4. Prohibition.
- 29 Except as provided in section 5, a covenant not to compete is
- 30 illegal, unenforceable and void as a matter of law. No court may

- 1 rewrite a covenant not to compete.
- 2 Section 5. Exceptions.
- 3 A covenant not to compete that satisfies any of the following
- 4 shall not be subject to section 4:
- 5 (1) A covenant not to compete that is reasonable and
- 6 involves an owner of a business that sells the business or
- 7 sells the goodwill in the business and that is reasonable.
- 8 (2) A covenant not to compete that involves a
- 9 dissolution or disassociation of a partnership or a limited
- 10 liability company.
- 11 (3) A covenant not to compete that is reasonable, in
- 12 effect prior to the effective date of this section and may
- 13 not be renewed.
- 14 Section 6. Attorney fees and damages.
- 15 An employee shall:
- 16 (1) Receive an award of attorney fees after prevailing
- in a suit against an employer related to the enforcement of a
- 18 covenant not to compete.
- 19 (2) Be entitled to damages, including punitive damages,
- after prevailing in a suit against an employer related to the
- 21 enforcement of a covenant not to compete.
- 22 Section 7. Venue, personal jurisdiction and governing law.
- 23 A dispute arising out of or related to a covenant not to
- 24 compete involving a resident of this Commonwealth shall be:
- 25 (1) Exclusively decided by a State court within this
- 26 Commonwealth.
- 27 (2) Governed by the laws of this Commonwealth.
- 28 Section 8. Effective date.
- 29 This act shall take effect immediately.
