AN ACT

Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled "An act relating to counties of the second class and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in district attorney, assistants and detectives, further providing for filling of vacancies.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1404 of the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the Second Class County Code, is amended to read:

Section 1404. Filling of Vacancies.--If any vacancy shall occur in the office of district attorney, either by death, resignation, removal from office or from the county, or otherwise[, the judges of the court of common pleas shall supply such vacancy by the appointment of a competent person to fill the office during the balance of the unexpired term.] the first assistant district attorney shall become district attorney and discharge the duties of the district attorney until the first Monday in January following the next municipal election
