AN ACT

1 Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in preliminary provisions, further providing for  
3 definitions; in registration system, further providing for  
4 departmental responsibilities and for SURE system; in voter  
5 registration, further providing for methods of voter  
6 registration and for application with driver's license  
7 application, providing for Commonwealth agencies and other  
8 entities and further providing for preparation and  
9 distribution of applications and for approval of registration  
10 applications; and providing for privacy and security  
11 standards for voter registration in this Commonwealth.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. The definitions of "applicant," "registration  
15 card" and "registration records" in section 1102 of Title 25 of  
16 the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the  
17 section is amended by adding a definition to read:

18 § 1102. Definitions.

19 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent  
20 provisions of this part which are applicable to specific  
21 provisions of this part, the following words and phrases when  
22 used in this part shall have the meanings given to them in this

1 section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

2 "Applicant." An individual who is automatically registered  
3 or who applies to be registered to vote as provided for in this  
4 part.

5 \* \* \*

6 "Employment or program application." All of the following:

7 (1) An application for employment filed with any of the  
8 following:

9 (i) The Bureau of State Employment.

10 (ii) An independent agency of this Commonwealth.

11 (iii) The State Civil Service Commission.

12 (2) An application for any financial assistance,  
13 compensation, benefit or service available, offered or to  
14 which the individual is entitled pursuant to any program  
15 administered by the following:

16 (i) The Department of Aging.

17 (ii) The Department of Health.

18 (iii) The Department of Human Services.

19 (iv) The Insurance Department.

20 (v) The Department of Labor and Industry.

21 (vi) The Department of Military and Veterans  
22 Affairs.

23 (vii) The Department of Revenue.

24 (viii) The Treasury Department.

25 (ix) The Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency.

26 (x) Any other offices in this Commonwealth that  
27 provide public assistance or that provide State-funded  
28 programs primarily engaged in providing services to low-  
29 income individuals, the elderly or individuals with  
30 disabilities.

1           (3) An application for admission to a State-owned or  
2           State-related institution of higher education in this  
3           Commonwealth.

4           (4) An application for financial assistance filed with  
5           the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency.

6           \* \* \*

7           "Registration card." A registration record, including an  
8           electronic record, containing all information required on the  
9           registration application, including the elector's signature or  
10          electronic signature, and suitable space for the insertion by  
11          the appropriate official of the following information:

12                 (1) The ward and election district of residence.

13                 (2) The registrant's street address.

14                 (3) Data required to be given upon removal from the  
15                 registrant's residence.

16                 (4) The date of each election at which the registrant  
17                 votes.

18                 (5) The number and letter of the stub of the ballot  
19                 issued to the registrant or the registrant's number in the  
20                 order of admission to the voting machines.

21                 (6) The initials of the election officer who enters the  
22                 record of voting in the district register.

23                 (7) Whether the registrant needs assistance to vote and,  
24                 if so, the nature of the disability.

25           "Registration records." The general register, district  
26           register and any other record of registration, including an  
27           electronic record, maintained by a commission. The term includes  
28           any record maintained by the commission on the Statewide Uniform  
29           Registry of Electors.

1 Section 2. Sections 1201, 1222(c)(8), 1321 and 1323 of Title  
2 25 are amended to read:

3 § 1201. Departmental responsibilities.

4 The department shall do all of the following:

5 (1) Provide for applicants to submit their voter  
6 registration application to a commission, the Department of  
7 Transportation and other agencies designated in section 1325  
8 (relating to government agencies).

9 (2) Prescribe a procedure for the return of completed  
10 voter registration applications from and the schedule by  
11 which the Department of Transportation, the Department of  
12 [Public Welfare] Human Services, armed forces recruitment  
13 centers, Offices of the Clerk of Orphan's Court and all other  
14 offices authorized under [this part to the secretary or the  
15 appropriate commission.] sections 1323 (relating to automatic  
16 registration with driver's license application), 1325 and  
17 1325.1 (relating to Commonwealth agencies and other entities)  
18 to register individuals to vote shall provide to the  
19 department electronic records containing the legal name, age,  
20 residence and citizenship information for, and the electronic  
21 signature of, each individual who meets qualifications  
22 identified by the secretary by guideline for automatic  
23 registration.

24 (3) Develop, establish, implement and administer a  
25 Statewide Uniform Registry of Electors in accordance with  
26 Subchapter B (relating to Statewide Uniform Registry of  
27 Electors (SURE)).

28 (4) Promulgate regulations necessary to administer this  
29 part.

30 § 1222. SURE system.

1 \* \* \*

2 (c) Requirements.--The SURE system shall be developed as a  
3 single, uniform integrated computer system. All commissions  
4 shall be connected electronically to the SURE system and shall  
5 maintain their registration records in the system. The SURE  
6 system shall, at a minimum, do all of the following:

7 \* \* \*

8 (8) Provide for the electronic transfer of voter  
9 registration information transmitted pursuant to section 1502  
10 (relating to transfer of registration), completed voter  
11 registration applications and changes of address in  
12 accordance with this part.

13 \* \* \*

14 § 1321. Methods of voter registration.

15 (a) Application.--An individual qualified to register to  
16 vote under section 1301(a) (relating to qualifications to  
17 register) may apply to register [as follows] in accordance with:

18 (1) [Under section] Section 1322 (relating to in-person  
19 voter registration).

20 (2) [Under section] Section 1323 (relating to  
21 [application] automatic registration with driver's license  
22 application).

23 (3) [Under section] Section 1324 (relating to  
24 application by mail).

25 (4) [Under section] Section 1325 (relating to government  
26 agencies).

27 (b) Automatic registration.--An individual qualified to  
28 register to vote under section 1301(a) who applies for or uses  
29 government services pursuant to section 1323 or 1325.1 (relating  
30 to Commonwealth agencies and other entities) shall be registered

1 automatically unless an individual chooses not to register  
2 automatically as provided for in this chapter.

3 § 1323. [Application] Automatic registration with driver's  
4 license application.

5 (a) General rule.--

6 (1) The Department of Transportation shall provide for  
7 simultaneous [application for] voter registration in  
8 conjunction with the process under 75 Pa.C.S. § 1510  
9 (relating to issuance and content of driver's license). An  
10 application under this subsection shall serve as an  
11 application to register to vote unless the applicant fails to  
12 sign the voter registration application.

13 (1.1) The secretary shall prescribe a procedure and  
14 schedule by which the Department of Transportation shall  
15 collect voter information and provide to the department  
16 electronic registration records containing the legal name,  
17 age, residence and the electronic signature of each  
18 individual who reports being a citizen of the United States,  
19 is subject to penalties under 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to  
20 unsworn falsification to authorities) and meets  
21 qualifications identified by the secretary. The secretary has  
22 the primary responsibility for implementing and enforcing the  
23 driver's license voter registration system created under this  
24 section. The secretary, in consultation with the Secretary of  
25 Transportation, may promulgate regulations for implementing  
26 this section.

27 (1.2) Upon receiving the electronic registration record  
28 for, and electronic signature of, an individual described in  
29 paragraph (1.1), the secretary shall provide the information  
30 to the commission in which the individual may be registered

1 as an elector under the laws of this Commonwealth and under  
2 the National Voter Registration Act of 1993 (Public Law 103-  
3 31, 52 U.S.C. § 20501 et seq.). The commission shall provide  
4 each individual with the process to:

5 (i) Decline being registered as a voter.

6 (ii) Adopt a political party affiliation, along with  
7 information as to which elections require a political  
8 party affiliation for participation.

9 (1.3) If an individual notified under paragraph (1.2)  
10 does not decline to be registered as an elector within 21  
11 calendar days after the commission issues the notification,  
12 the individual's electronic registration record and  
13 electronic signature submitted under paragraph (1.1) shall  
14 constitute a completed voter registration application for  
15 purposes of this chapter. The individual shall be registered  
16 to vote if the individual is eligible to vote under the laws  
17 of this Commonwealth and is not already registered to vote.

18 (1.4) An individual notified under paragraph (1.2) who  
19 does not decline to be registered as an elector within 21  
20 calendar days after the commission issues the notification  
21 and does not adopt a political party affiliation shall be  
22 required to adopt a political party affiliation prior to  
23 voting at the next primary election at which the individual  
24 exercises his or her right to vote. If no such political  
25 affiliation is adopted, an individual shall be permitted to  
26 vote at the next election that does not require a political  
27 party affiliation to participate.

28 (1.5) A commission may not send a ballot to, or add to  
29 an elector registration list, an individual who does not have  
30 a completed registration under paragraph (1.2).

1           (2) An application for voter registration or automatic  
2 registration submitted to the Department of Transportation  
3 under this subsection shall be considered as updating any  
4 previous voter registration information by a registrant.

5           (3) Any change of address submitted to the Department of  
6 Transportation for the purposes of driver licensing or an  
7 identification card under 75 Pa.C.S. § 1510 shall serve as  
8 notification of change of address for voter registration for  
9 the registrant involved unless the registrant indicates that  
10 the change of address is not for voter registration purposes.

11       (b) Process.--

12           (1) The Department of Transportation shall both provide  
13 for an application for voter registration as part of a  
14 driver's license application[.] and collect voter  
15 registration information as part of an application submitted  
16 under 75 Pa.C.S. § 1510 by an individual who meets the  
17 qualifications to register under section 1301(a) (relating to  
18 qualifications to register).

19           (2) The format of the driver's license/voter  
20 registration application and information to be collected  
21 shall be determined and prescribed by the secretary and the  
22 Secretary of Transportation[.] and shall include all the  
23 requirements of an official voter registration application  
24 specified in section 1327 (relating to preparation and  
25 distribution of applications).

26           (3) The voter registration application portion of the  
27 application shall contain all the requirements of an official  
28 voter registration application specified in section 1327  
29 [(relating to preparation and distribution of applications)].

30 The voter registration portion of the application:



1 (i) may not require any information that duplicates  
2 information required in the driver's license portion of  
3 the form, other than a second signature; and

4 (ii) may require only the minimum amount of  
5 information necessary to prevent duplicate voter  
6 registration, to enable the commission to assess the  
7 eligibility of the applicant and to administer voter  
8 registration and other parts of the election process.

9 (c) Transmission.--

10 (1) The Department of Transportation shall forward  
11 completed applications or contents of the completed voter  
12 registration applications in machine-readable format to the  
13 department by the close of registration for the ensuing  
14 election. The Department of Transportation shall forward the  
15 electronic registration record containing the information set  
16 forth in subsection (a)(1.1) to the secretary as prescribed  
17 by section 1201(2) (relating to departmental  
18 responsibilities) regarding an individual who reports being a  
19 citizen of the United States, subject to penalties under 18  
20 Pa.C.S. § 4904.

21 (2) [The] Upon receipt, the department shall transmit  
22 the material to the appropriate commission within ten days  
23 after the date of its receipt by the Department of  
24 Transportation. If a voter registration application is  
25 received by the Department of Transportation within five days  
26 before the last day to register before an election, the  
27 application shall be transmitted to the appropriate  
28 commission not later than five days after the date of its  
29 receipt by the Department of Transportation.

30 (3) (i) Upon receipt of the completed voter

1 registration information from the department, the  
2 commission shall make a record of the date of the receipt  
3 of the application or electronic registration record and  
4 process the application. No applicant shall be deemed  
5 eligible to vote until the commission has received and  
6 approved the application. Upon receipt of an electronic  
7 registration record from the department, the commission  
8 shall notify the individual of the process to:

9 (A) Decline being registered as a voter.

10 (B) Adopt a political party affiliation, along  
11 with information as to which elections require a  
12 political party affiliation for participation.

13 (ii) If an individual notified under subparagraph  
14 (i) does not decline to be registered as an elector  
15 within 21 calendar days after the commission issues the  
16 notification, the individual's electronic record and  
17 electronic signature submitted under paragraph (1) shall  
18 constitute a completed voter registration application for  
19 purposes of this chapter. The individual shall be  
20 registered to vote if the individual is eligible to vote  
21 under the laws of this Commonwealth and is not already  
22 registered to vote.

23 (iii) A commission may not send a ballot to, or add  
24 to an elector registration list, an individual who does  
25 not have a completed voter registration under  
26 subparagraph (ii).

27 (3.1) After the Department of Transportation is  
28 connected to the SURE system and notwithstanding paragraphs  
29 (1), (2) and (3), the Department of Transportation shall  
30 transmit electronically the contents of a completed voter

1 registration application within five days of receipt of the  
2 application. The Department of Transportation shall transmit  
3 the electronic registration records of individuals who have  
4 reported, subject to penalties under 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904, that  
5 the individual is a citizen of the United States and shall  
6 contain the information in subsection (a)(1.1) within 24  
7 hours of collection of the information. Upon receipt of the  
8 information from the Department of Transportation, a  
9 commission shall, in the case of an application, make a  
10 record of the date of the receipt of the application and  
11 process the application in accordance with section 1328  
12 (relating to approval of registration applications) or, in  
13 the case of an electronic registration record, proceed in  
14 accordance with paragraph (3). If the commission of the  
15 county of residence has not been connected to the SURE  
16 system, the Department of Transportation shall forward the  
17 completed application or contents of the completed  
18 application or the electronic registration record to the  
19 department in accordance with paragraph (1). No applicant  
20 shall be deemed eligible to vote until the commission has  
21 received and approved an application in accordance with  
22 section 1328.

23 (4) Changes of address shall comply with the following:

24 (i) Before the Department of Transportation is  
25 connected to the SURE system, the Department of  
26 Transportation shall notify the department of changes of  
27 address received under subsection (a)(3). The department  
28 shall notify the commission of the county of the  
29 registrant's former residence. After the Department of  
30 Transportation is connected to the SURE system, the

1 Department of Transportation shall notify the commission  
2 of the county of the registrant's former residence. If  
3 the registrant has moved to an address outside this  
4 Commonwealth, the commission shall verify the address  
5 change in accordance with section 1901 (relating to  
6 removal of electors). Except as provided in subparagraph  
7 (ii), if the registrant confirms in accordance with  
8 section 1901(d) that he has moved to another county, the  
9 commission shall cancel the registration and forward the  
10 registrant's registration information to the commission  
11 of the registrant's new county of residence. Except as  
12 provided in subparagraph (ii), if the registrant has  
13 moved to an address within the commission's jurisdiction,  
14 the commission shall promptly update the registration  
15 record of the registrant in accordance with section 1328.  
16 All changes of address received by the Department of  
17 Transportation under this section at least 30 days before  
18 an election must be processed by the commission for the  
19 ensuing election. For the purpose of this paragraph, the  
20 term "registration information" means the registration  
21 card and any other record of registration maintained by a  
22 commission.

23 (ii) In the case of changes of address received by  
24 the Department of Transportation which do not contain a  
25 signature of the registrant, the commission receiving the  
26 change of address notification shall mail a notice to the  
27 registrant at the new residence address requesting  
28 verification of the address change. If the change of  
29 address is to a new residence outside the commission's  
30 jurisdiction, the commission shall mail the following

1 notice:

2 Date.....

3 Office of the Registration Commission

4 ..... County, Pennsylvania

5 ..... (Address and Telephone No. of County)

6 We have been notified by the Department of Transportation  
7 that you recently changed your address

8 from ..... (old residence address)

9 to ..... (new residence address) and that this

10 change of address is to serve as a change of address for

11 voter registration purposes. Unless you notify this

12 office within ten days from the date of this notice that

13 this information is not correct, your voter registration

14 will be transferred to ..... County. You may notify

15 this office by writing your residence address, the date

16 and your signature on the bottom of this form and mailing

17 this notice to this office. You need not notify this

18 office if this information is correct.

21 If the address change is within the commission's  
22 jurisdiction, the commission shall mail a voter's  
23 identification card to the registrant at the new  
24 residence address.

25 (iii) If the registrant does not return the notice  
26 under subparagraph (ii) within the ten-day period, the  
27 commission shall process the change of address according  
28 to subparagraph (i). If the registrant notifies the  
29 commission that the information is incorrect and the  
30 commission is satisfied with the registrant's explanation

1 of the discrepancy, the address of the registrant's  
2 registration shall remain unchanged. If the verification  
3 notification or voter identification card is returned by  
4 the post office as undeliverable as addressed or with a  
5 forwarding address, the commission shall send a  
6 confirmation notice to the registrant's address of former  
7 residence in accordance with section 1901(d)(2).

8 (5) Upon notification and confirmation of any change of  
9 address, a commission shall promptly update information  
10 contained in its registration record.

11 (d) Prohibition.--[An] The Department of Transportation may  
12 not register to vote under this section an individual who is not  
13 a qualified elector [is ineligible to register to vote under  
14 this section].

15 (e) Effect.--Failure to properly complete a voter  
16 registration application or refusal to provide voter  
17 registration information shall not affect the validity of an  
18 application for a driver's license, a renewal application or an  
19 identification card application.

20 (f) Use of information.--No information regarding a  
21 declination to register to vote in connection with an  
22 application [made] submitted or not submitted if an individual  
23 has not certified that the individual is a citizen of the United  
24 States, subject to penalties under 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904, under this  
25 section may be used for any purpose other than voter  
26 registration.

27 (g) Staff.--Agents and employees working on behalf of the  
28 Department of Transportation assisting in the completion of  
29 voter registration applications or collecting voter registration  
30 information under this section shall conduct themselves in a

1 manner consistent with the following principles:

2 (1) They shall not seek to influence an applicant's  
3 political preference or party registration or display  
4 political preference or party allegiance.

5 (2) They shall not make a statement to an applicant or  
6 take an action the purpose or effect of which is to  
7 discourage the applicant from registering to vote or  
8 providing voter registration information.

9 (3) Applicants wishing to register to vote under this  
10 section shall be given the same degree of assistance with the  
11 voter registration application as with all other Department  
12 of Transportation forms.

13 Agency employees who violate this subsection or who fail to  
14 collect the information required under subsection (a)(1.1) or  
15 fail to forward the information to the department or the SURE  
16 system shall be removed from employment, provided that the  
17 agency at its discretion may impose a penalty of suspension  
18 without pay for at least 30 days, but not more than 120 days, if  
19 it finds that the violation does not warrant termination.

20 Section 3. Title 25 is amended by adding a section to read:  
21 § 1325.1. Commonwealth agencies and other entities.

22 (a) Administration.--The secretary shall administer a system  
23 whereby each individual submitting an employment or program  
24 application shall provide for simultaneous voter registration in  
25 conjunction with an employment or program application filed with  
26 the agency or entity.

27 (b) Procedure.--The secretary shall prescribe a procedure  
28 and schedule by which each entity under this section shall  
29 provide to the department electronic records containing the  
30 legal name, age, residence and citizenship information for, and

1 the electronic signature of, each individual who has certified  
2 that the individual is a citizen of the United States, subject  
3 to penalties under 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn  
4 falsification to authorities), and any other information  
5 required under this chapter.

6 (c) Effect.--Refusal to provide voter registration  
7 information shall not affect the validity of an employment or  
8 program application, consideration of the application or  
9 eligibility for any financial assistance, compensation, benefit  
10 or service available, offered or to which the individual is  
11 entitled pursuant to any program.

12 (d) Staff.--

13 (1) Agency or entity employees collecting voter  
14 registration information under this section shall conduct  
15 themselves in a manner consistent with the following  
16 principles:

17 (i) The employee may not seek to influence an  
18 applicant's political preference or party registration or  
19 display political preference or party allegiance.

20 (ii) The employee may not make a statement to an  
21 applicant or take an action the purpose of or effect of  
22 which is to discourage the applicant from providing voter  
23 registration information.

24 (iii) The employee may not make a statement to an  
25 applicant or take an action the purpose of or effect of  
26 which is to lead the applicant to believe that refusing  
27 to provide voter registration information has any bearing  
28 on the application, including its consideration, the  
29 likelihood of employment or, in the case of an  
30 application to a State-owned or State-related university,



1 acceptance, or the availability of services or benefits.

2 (2) Agency or entity employees who violate this  
3 subsection, who fail to collect the information required  
4 under subsection (b) or fail to forward the information to  
5 the department shall be removed from employment, except that  
6 the agency or entity at its discretion may impose a penalty  
7 of suspension without pay for at least 30 days, but not more  
8 than 120 days, if it finds that the violation does not  
9 warrant termination.

10 (e) Encouraging registration.--Agencies and entities subject  
11 to this section must provide reasonable space for nonpartisan  
12 signs or posters advising individuals of automatic voter  
13 registration. The signs and posters shall be provided by the  
14 secretary.

15 (f) Transmission.--The following shall apply:

16 (1) Agencies and entities subject to this section shall  
17 forward the electronic registration record of individuals who  
18 certify that the individual is a citizen of the United  
19 States, subject to penalties under 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904,  
20 containing the information in subsection (b) to the secretary  
21 as prescribed by section 1201(2) (relating to departmental  
22 responsibilities).

23 (2) Upon receipt, the department shall transmit the  
24 material to the appropriate commission.

25 (3) Upon receipt of the electronic record from the  
26 department, the commission shall notify the individual of the  
27 process to:

28 (i) Decline being registered as a voter.

29 (ii) Adopt a political party affiliation, along with  
30 information as to which elections require a political

1 party affiliation for participation.

2 (4) The individual's electronic record and electronic  
3 signature submitted under paragraph (1) shall constitute a  
4 completed voter registration card for purposes of this  
5 chapter. The individual shall be registered to vote if the  
6 individual is eligible to vote under the laws of this  
7 Commonwealth and is not already registered to vote.

8 (5) An individual notified under paragraph (3) who does  
9 not decline to be registered as an elector within 21 calendar  
10 days after the commission issues the notification and does  
11 not adopt a political party affiliation shall be required to  
12 adopt a political party affiliation prior to voting at the  
13 next primary election at which the individual exercises the  
14 individual's right to vote. If no such political affiliation  
15 is adopted, an individual shall be permitted to vote at the  
16 next election that does not require a political party  
17 affiliation to participate.

18 (6) A commission may not send a ballot to, or add to an  
19 elector registration list, an individual who does not have a  
20 completed voter registration pursuant to paragraph (4).

21 (g) Confidentiality.--The identity of an agency or entity  
22 through which a particular voter is registered in accordance  
23 with this section may not be disclosed to the public.

24 (h) Use of information.--No information relating to voter  
25 registration collected by agencies or entities, including, but  
26 not limited to, an individual's citizenship status under this  
27 section or information relating to an individual's election to  
28 decline to register as a voter may be used for a purpose other  
29 than voter registration.

30 (i) Regulation.--The secretary shall promulgate regulations

1 regarding the maintenance and destruction of forms used pursuant  
2 to this section.

3 Section 4. Sections 1327(a)(3) and (4) and (b)(3) and  
4 1328(b) and (c)(1) and (2) of Title 25 are amended to read:

5 § 1327. Preparation and distribution of applications.

6 (a) Form.--

7 \* \* \*

8 (3) Any person who assists in the completion of the  
9 registration application shall sign the application and  
10 indicate the person's address. In the case of those  
11 [registering] automatically registered electronically under  
12 [sections] section 1323 (relating to [application] automatic  
13 registration with driver's license application) [and], 1325  
14 (relating to government agencies) or 1325.1 (relating to  
15 Commonwealth agencies and other entities), the person  
16 providing assistance shall insert the person's initials or  
17 employee or agent identification number on a separate or  
18 detachable portion of the application or the computer data  
19 file.

20 (4) A voter registration application shall be printed on  
21 stock of good quality and shall be of suitable uniform size.  
22 Nothing in this part shall prohibit the design and use of an  
23 electronic voter registration application which includes the  
24 applicant's digitized or electronic signature. The  
25 registration application shall contain the following  
26 information; however, the information may be provided on a  
27 separate form for automatic voter registration made under  
28 section 1323 [or], 1325 or 1325.1:

29 (i) Notice that a registered elector does not need  
30 to reregister unless the registered elector has moved.

22 2001. Establishment of privacy and security standards.

27 § 2001. Establishment of privacy and security standards.

28 The secretary shall establish standards and procedures to  
29 safeguard the privacy of the residents of this Commonwealth and  
30 the integrity and security of the information on the Statewide

1 voter registration database.

2 § 2002. Regulations, policies and enforcement procedures.

3 (a) Regulations.--The secretary shall promulgate regulations  
4 regarding privacy and security policies specifying each class of  
5 users who shall have authorized access to the Statewide voter  
6 registration database, specifying for each class the permissions  
7 and levels of access to be granted, and providing for other  
8 safeguards to protect the privacy and security of the  
9 information on the Statewide voter registration database. The  
10 regulations shall:

11 (1) prohibit public disclosure of certain voter  
12 information, including the source for a voter's registration  
13 and any information not necessary to voter registration;

14 (2) protect against public disclosure of Social Security  
15 numbers, driver's license numbers and signatures;

16 (3) prohibit public disclosure of an individual's  
17 decision not to register to vote;

18 (4) prohibit Commonwealth agencies from transmitting to  
19 election officials information other than that required for  
20 voter registration or specific information relevant to the

24       Any individual who is not eligible to vote and who becomes  
25 registered under law may not be found on that basis to have made  
26 a false claim to citizenship or to have committed an act

29 United States citizen after the date on which the individual is  
30 registered to vote in this Commonwealth. If an individual who is

6 (a) Registration use prohibited.--A person may not use the

11 pertaining to elections.

12 (b) Information use prohibited.--Information relating to an  
13 individual's absence from the Statewide voter registration  
14 database or an individual's refusal to supply information for  
15 voter registration purposes at a source may not be disclosed to  
16 the public or used for any purpose other than voter  
17 registration, election administration or the enforcement of the  
18 laws of this Commonwealth against crimes pertaining to  
19 elections.

20 (c) Nondiscrimination.--A person may not discriminate  
21 against any individual on the basis of the individual's absence  
22 from the Statewide voter registration database, the information  
23 supplied by the individual for voter registration purposes at a  
24 source or the individual's refusal to supply the information,  
25 except as required to administer elections or enforce the laws  
26 of this Commonwealth against crimes pertaining to elections.
