10	Section 1. Section 1002(a) of the act of June 2, 1915
11	(P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, is
12	amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to

14	Section 1002. (a) An insured employer may make application
15	to the department for the certification of any established
16	safety committee operative within its workplace developed for
17	the purpose of hazard detection $[and]_{\boldsymbol{L}}$ accident prevention <u>and</u>
18	providing information regarding the risks associated with
19	substance abuse, including opioid painkiller use. The department
20	shall develop such certification criteria.

3	for employers to comply with this section.
