1 2 3	Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in employees, providing for medals honoring fire personnel.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Chapter 21 of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read:
8	SUBCHAPTER F
9	MEDALS HONORING FIRE PERSONNEL

14	<u>§ 2191. Establishment of program.</u>
15	A program is established for the Governor to recognize and
16	decorate fire personnel in this Commonwealth who have

1	demonstrated bravery, sacrifice or other exceptionally
2	meritorious conduct in the line of duty. The State Fire
3	Commissioner shall assist the Governor in the administration of
4	the program by establishing the qualifications, protocol and
5	other rules necessary to carry out the purposes of this
6	subchapter.
7	<u>§ 2192. Medal procedure.</u>
8	(a) NomineesA member of a fire company may be nominated
9	for a medal under this subchapter.
10	(b) ApplicationAn application that nominates a member of
11	a fire company for a medal may be submitted to the State Fire
12	Commissioner by the Governor, a member of the General Assembly
13	or the chief executive of a municipality or fire company.
14	(c) Review and issuance of medalsThe State Fire
15	Commissioner shall review an application's veracity and
16	conformance to the criteria of the program and notify the
17	Governor of the applications that are in compliance. The final
18	decision to issue a medal under this subchapter shall rest with
19	the Governor. The Governor may delegate to the Lieutenant
20	Governor or a member of the General Assembly the act of
21	presenting a medal.
22	<u>§ 2193. Form of medals.</u>
23	(a) General ruleThe medals authorized under the program
24	shall be in the following forms:
25	(1) Red Star of Valor, which may be awarded to members
26	of a fire company who have shown exceptional gallantry,
27	heroism and bravery in the face of life-threatening
28	circumstances above and beyond the call of duty.
29	(2) Red Heart, which may be issued to members of a fire
30	company injured in the line of duty.

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1	(3) Medal of Ultimate Sacrifice, which shall be issued
2	posthumously to members of a fire company who have fallen in
3	the line of duty.
4	(b) DesignThe design of each medal shall be approved by
5	the State Fire Commissioner. Each medal shall be cast in bronze
6	or other metal, and the design shall incorporate the seal of the
7	Commonwealth.
8	(c) CostThe cost of a medal shall be paid by the fire
9	company by which the member of the fire company is or was
10	employed or volunteered. The family of a medal recipient may
11	request a second medal and may receive the medal upon payment to
12	the Office of the State Fire Commissioner of the cost of the
13	medal.
14	(d) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
15	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
16	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
17	"Fire company." A volunteer fire company, a municipal fire
18	company or a combined volunteer and municipal fire company
19	located in this Commonwealth.
20	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
