AN ACT
Amending Title 3 (Agriculture) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in food protection, prohibiting return of groceries and other foodstuffs during COVID-19 disaster emergency.
The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Title 3 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
\$ 5711.1. Prohibiting return of groceries and other foodstuffs during COVID-19 disaster emergency.
(a) General rule.--Except as otherwise provided in
subsection (b), no proprietor of a retail food establishment may accept the return of any groceries and other foodstuffs purchased by a consumer during, and for 30 days following termination of, the proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and any renewal of the state of disaster emergency.
(b) Exception.--Subsection (a) shall not apply if:
(1) the proprietor determines, in the proprietor's sole

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
