AN ACT

- Amending Title 3 (Agriculture) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
 Statutes, in food protection, prohibiting return of groceries
 and other foodstuffs during COVID-19 disaster emergency.

 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 hereby enacts as follows:

 Section 1. Title 3 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes
 is amended by adding a section to read:

 \$\frac{5}{5711.1.} \text{ Prohibiting return of groceries and other foodstuffs}

 during COVID-19 disaster emergency.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- Except as otherwise provided in
- 11 <u>subsection</u> (b), no proprietor of a retail food establishment may
- 12 accept the return of any groceries and other foodstuffs
- 13 purchased by a consumer during, and for 30 days following
- 14 termination of, the proclamation of disaster emergency issued by
- 15 the Governor on March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March
- 16 <u>21, 2020), and any renewal of the state of disaster emergency.</u>
- 17 <u>(b) Exception.--Subsection (a) shall not apply if:</u>
- 18 <u>(1) the proprietor determines, in the proprietor's sole</u>

- 1 <u>discretion</u>, that the groceries and other foodstuffs are
- 2 unsafe for use or otherwise adulterated as a result of any
- 3 manufacturing error or defect; and
- 4 (2) the groceries and other foodstuffs are not offered
- 5 <u>for resale.</u>
- 6 (c) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term
- 7 "groceries and other foodstuffs" shall mean dairy products, meat
- 8 and delicatessen products, produce products, seafood products,
- 9 carbonated beverages, coffee and other beverages, snack foods,
- 10 candy products, baked products, paper products, household
- 11 cleaning items, health and beauty products, frozen foods, pet
- 12 <u>foods and supplies and any other edible product.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
