## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 7 8 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 12 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation 17 18 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of 19 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be 20 determined," providing for COVID-19 vaccine distribution. 21 22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 23 hereby enacts as follows: 24 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known 25 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding an 26 article to read:

- 3 The following words and phrases when used in this article
- 4 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 5 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 6 <u>"COVID-19." The novel coronavirus identified in the</u>
- 7 Governor's proclamation of disaster emergency issued on March 6,
- 8 <u>2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020).</u>
- 9 <u>"COVID-19 Interim Vaccination Plan." The interim plan</u>
- 10 developed by the department to inform residents of this
- 11 Commonwealth about the administration of the COVID-19 vaccine in
- 12 <u>accordance with recommendations from the United States</u>
- 13 <u>Department of Health and Human Services and the Advisory</u>
- 14 <u>Committee on Immunization Practices under the Centers for</u>
- 15 Disease Control and Prevention.
- 16 "COVID-19 vaccine." A vaccine for COVID-19 that has received
- 17 an emergency use authorization from the United States Food and
- 18 <u>Drug Administration</u>.
- 19 "Department." The Department of Health of the Commonwealth.
- 20 Section 2102-E. COVID-19 Interim Vaccination Plan.
- 21 Notwithstanding any other law, regulation or order, the
- 22 department shall authorize individuals with type 1 diabetes in
- 23 this Commonwealth to receive the COVID-19 vaccine under Phase 1A
- 24 of the COVID-19 Interim Vaccination Plan.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
