- 1 Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes, in employees, providing for use of
- 3 criminal background information.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 53 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 2172. Use of criminal background information.
- 9 (a) Authorized use. -- A municipal law enforcement agency may
- 10 <u>use criminal history record information as provided in 18</u>
- 11 Pa.C.S. Ch. 91 (relating to criminal history record information)
- 12 to judge the qualifications and suitability of an applicant for
- 13 employment as a police officer in the municipality.
- (b) Waiver.--Whenever a municipal law enforcement agency is
- 15 in receipt of information which is part of an applicant's
- 16 criminal history record information file that would disqualify
- 17 the applicant due to a criminal conviction, the municipal law
- 18 enforcement agency may waive the disqualification based on the

- 1 <u>criminal conviction if the municipal law enforcement agency does</u>
- 2 all of the following:
- 3 (1) Determines that the criminal conviction is not
- 4 graded as a felony or misdemeanor of the first degree.
- 5 (2) Investigates the circumstances of the criminal_
- 6 conviction to determine whether and to the extent the
- 7 criminal conviction relates to the applicant's suitability
- 8 <u>for employment in the position for which he or she has</u>
- 9 <u>applied.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
