- 1 Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, in registration and titling of boats, further
- providing for period of registration.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 5308 of Title 30 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 5308. Period of registration.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Except as otherwise provided in
- 10 <u>subsection</u> (b):
- 11 (1) Registrations issued under this subchapter to owners
- 12 and dealers shall be valid from April 1 of one year to March
- 13 31 of the succeeding year and shall be renewable. A
- 14 registration for any year shall be valid and may properly be
- displayed prior to April 1 within that year.
- 16 (2) The commission may determine to issue registrations
- 17 valid for a period not to exceed three years upon payment of
- 18 a fee equal to the annual registration fee times the number

of years for which the multiple-year registration is valid. A

2 multiple-year registration shall be valid from April 1 of the

3 year of its issuance until March 31 of the last year of its

4 validity, but a multiple-year registration issued prior to

5 April 1 of any year is valid and may be displayed at any time

6 within that year.

- 7 (3) The commission may, by regulation, provide for the 8 transfer of multiple-year registrations upon the sale or 9 conveyance of a boat upon payment of the fee provided in 10 section 5104(8) (relating to fees).
- 11 (b) Calendar-year registrations.--Registrations issued on or
 12 after the effective date of this subsection shall be subject to
- 13 the following provisions:
- 14 <u>(1) Registrations issued under this subchapter to owners</u>
- and dealers shall be valid from January 1 through December 31
- of the calendar year and shall be renewable. A registration
- for a calendar year shall be valid and may properly be
- displayed at any time through December 31 of the calendar
- 19 year of its issuance.
- 20 (2) The commission may determine to issue registrations
- 21 <u>valid for a period not to exceed three years upon payment of</u>
- 22 a fee equal to the calendar year registration fee times the
- 23 number of calendar years for which the multiple-calendar-year
- registration is valid. A multiple-calendar-year registration
- 25 shall be valid from January 1 of the calendar year of its
- issuance until December 31 of the last calendar year of its
- 27 <u>validity and may be displayed at any time through December 31</u>
- of the last calendar year of its issuance.
- 29 (3) The commission may, by regulation, provide for the
- 30 transfer of multiple-calendar-year registrations upon the

- 1 <u>sale or conveyance of a boat upon payment of the fee provided</u>
- 2 in section 5104(a)(8).
- 3 Section 2. Within 18 months of the effective date of this
- 4 section, the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission shall
- 5 promulgate and publish in the Pennsylvania Bulletin final
- 6 regulations to implement the amendment of 30 Pa.C.S. § 5308.
- 7 Section 3. This act shall take effect as follows:
- 8 (1) Section 2 of this act and this section shall take
- 9 effect immediately.
- 10 (2) The remainder of this act shall take effect upon
- 11 publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of the final
- 12 regulations under section 2 of this act.
