Amending the act of December 18, 1992 (P.L.1376, No.172), entitled "An act providing for the establishment and 2 administration of an affordable housing program; and imposing 3 additional powers and duties on the Department of Community 4 Affairs," further providing for National Affordable Housing 5 Act's HOME Program; and making editorial changes. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The title of the act of December 18, 1992 10 (P.L.1376, No.172), known as the Pennsylvania Affordable Housing Act, is amended to read: 11 12 AN ACT 13 Providing for the establishment and administration of an 14 affordable housing program; and imposing additional powers 15 and duties on the Department of Community [Affairs] and 16 Economic Development. 17 Section 2. Sections 2 and 5(b)(3)(i) and (v) of the act are 18 amended to read: Section 2. Definitions. 19

- 4 The Commonwealth's housing strategy and annual updates thereof

- 7 as the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 (NAHA).
- 8 "Department." The Department of Community [Affairs] and
- 9 Economic Development of the Commonwealth.
- 10 "HOME Investment Partnership Program" or "HOME program." The
- 11 Federal program authorized by the Cranston-Gonzalez National
- 12 Affordable Housing Act (Public Law 101-625, 42 U.S.C. § 12701 et
- 13 seq.), also known as the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990
- 14 (NAHA).
- 15 "HOME Investment Trust Fund" or "HOME fund." The account
- 16 established in the State Treasury for the HOME Investment
- 17 Partnership Program, as required by the Cranston-Gonzalez
- 18 National Affordable Housing Act (Public Law 101-625, 42 U.S.C. §
- 19 12701 et seq.), also known as the National Affordable Housing
- 20 Act of 1990 (NAHA), and the implementing regulations thereof.
- 21 "National Affordable Housing Act of 1990" or "NAHA." The
- 22 Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act (Public Law
- 23 101-625, 42 U.S.C. § 12701 et seq.), as amended.
- 24 "Nonprofit organization." Any private, nonprofit
- 25 organization, including a Federally chartered or State-chartered
- 26 nonprofit organization, that:
- 27 (1) Is organized under Federal or State law.
- 28 (2) Has no part of its net earnings inuring to the
- 29 benefit of any member, founder, contributor or individual.
- 30 (3) Has among its purposes activities related to the

- 1 provision of decent housing that is affordable to low-income
- 2 and moderate-income persons or activities that relate to the
- 3 provision of services that assist low-income persons.
- 4 "Pennsylvania Housing Advisory Committee" or "PHAC." The
- 5 committee established under this act to advise the Department of
- 6 Community [Affairs] and Economic Development on coordination of
- 7 Federal, State and local resources.
- 8 "Regional housing advisory committees" or "RHAC's." The six
- 9 regional committees established under this act to review
- 10 regional housing and support service needs and priorities and
- 11 advise the Department of Community [Affairs] and Economic
- 12 <u>Development</u> as to how these needs and priorities should be
- 13 addressed in the Commonwealth's Comprehensive Housing
- 14 Affordability Strategy.
- "Secretary." The Secretary of Community [Affairs] and
- 16 Economic Development of the Commonwealth.
- 17 "United States Department of Housing and Urban Development"
- 18 or "HUD." The Federal agency responsible for administering the
- 19 programs authorized under the Cranston-Gonzalez National
- 20 Affordable Housing Act (Public Law 101-625, 42 U.S.C § 12701 et
- 21 seq.), also known as the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990

- 6 Section 3. Section 6 of the act is amended by adding a
- 7 subsection to read:
- 8 Section 6. National Affordable Housing Act's HOME Program.

- 10 (c.1) Applicable wage rates. -- Rehabilitation projects funded
- 11 <u>under this act that are not subject to the Federal wage rate</u>
- 12 requirements under 40 U.S.C. §§ 3141 (relating to definitions),
- 13 3142 (relating to rate of wages for laborers and mechanics),
- 14 3143 (relating to termination of work on failure to pay agreed
- 15 wages), 3144 (relating to authority to pay wages and list
- 16 contractors violating contracts), 3146 (relating to effect on
- 17 other federal laws) and 3147 (relating to suspension of this
- 18 subchapter during a national emergency) or 41 U.S.C. Ch. 65
- 19 (relating to contracts for materials, supplies, articles, and
- 20 equipment exceeding \$10,000) shall not be subject to the wage
- 21 rate requirements under the act of August 15, 1961 (P.L.987,
- 22 No.442), known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act.
