AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for
3 contributions for breast cancer research.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 1323. Contributions for breast cancer research.

9 (a) General rule.--Within one year of the effective date of
10 this section, the department shall provide for all of the
11 following:

12 (1) Ability of a person renewing a driver's license or
13 identification card electronically through the department's
14 publicly accessible Internet website to make a contribution
15 of \$5 to the Pennsylvania Breast Cancer Coalition.

16 (2) Ability of a person renewing a vehicle registration

1 electronically through the department's publicly accessible
2 Internet website to make a contribution of \$5 to the
3 Pennsylvania Breast Cancer Coalition.

4 (b) Implementation.--

5 (1) A contribution under subsection (a) shall be added,
6 as appropriate, to the regular fee for:

7 (i) a renewal of a driver's license or
8 identification card; and

9 (ii) a renewal of a vehicle registration.

10 (2) One contribution under subsection (a) may be made
11 for:

12 (i) each renewal of a driver's license or
13 identification card; and

14 (ii) each renewal of a vehicle registration.

15 (c) Use.--Contributions under subsection (a) shall be used
16 exclusively for breast cancer research approved and administered
17 by the Pennsylvania Breast Cancer Coalition.

18 (d) Deposits.--The department shall determine annually the
19 total amount designated under this section, less reasonable
20 administrative costs, and shall report the amount to the State
21 Treasurer who shall transfer the amount from the Motor License
22 Fund to the Pennsylvania Breast Cancer Coalition.

23 (e) Information.--

24 (1) The department shall provide adequate information
25 concerning the contribution for breast cancer research in its
26 instructions for the applicants described in subsection (a).
27 The information concerning the contribution shall include the
28 address of the Pennsylvania Breast Cancer Coalition to which
29 contributions may be sent by individuals wishing to make
30 additional contributions.

1 (2) The Pennsylvania Breast Cancer Coalition shall
2 conduct a public information campaign on the availability of
3 this opportunity to Pennsylvania taxpayers.

4 (f) Reporting.--The Pennsylvania Breast Cancer Coalition
5 shall report annually to the respective committees of the Senate
6 and the House of Representatives that have jurisdiction over
7 health matters on the amount received from the contributions
8 authorized by this section and how the funds were used.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
