8	§ 7508.3. Drug trafficking near a drug and alcohol recovery

10	(a) Offense definedA person commits the offense of drug
11	trafficking near a drug and alcohol recovery house if the person
12	manufactures, delivers or possesses with the intent to
13	manufacture or deliver a controlled substance within 1,000 feet
14	of the real property on which a drug and alcohol recovery house
15	is located.
16	(b) GradingAn offense under this section constitutes a
17	<u>felony.</u>
18	(c) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following

1	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
2	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
3	"Controlled substance." A Schedule II, III or IV controlled
4	substance as defined in the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233,
5	No.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and
6	<u>Cosmetic Act.</u>
7	"Drug and alcohol recovery house." As defined in section
8	<u>2311-A of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as</u>
9	The Administrative Code of 1929.
10	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
