AN ACT

- Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for vaccinations.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 6 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:
- 7 CHAPTER 59

- 10 5901. Legislative policy and declarations.
- 11 <u>5902</u>. <u>Definitions</u>.
- 12 <u>5903</u>. Requirement to show proof of vaccination prohibited.
- 13 § 5901. Legislative policy and declarations.
- 14 The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
- 15 (1) None of the vaccines currently used to vaccinate
- 16 <u>against COVID-19 are approved medical products by the Federal</u>
- 17 Drug Administration and are instead being used under

- 1 <u>Emergency Use Authorization. Under Federal law, an individual</u>
- 2 must be given the option to accept or refuse administration
- 3 of the product.
- 4 (2) Many Pennsylvanians have not been able to receive a
- 5 <u>COVID-19 vaccine due to delays in administration of the</u>
- 6 <u>vaccines and many individuals cannot receive the vaccine due</u>
- 7 to illness.
- 8 (3) Vaccination records are private health information
- 9 <u>and should not be disclosed under government mandate.</u>
- 10 (4) A governmental requirement to obtain a vaccination
- infringes on individual freedom and harms patient privacy.
- 12 (5) Trusting business entities to make their own
- decisions is in the best interest of the business entities'
- employees and customers.
- 15 § 5902. Definitions.
- 16 As used in this chapter, the following words and phrases
- 17 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 18 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 19 "Business entity." A sole proprietorship, corporation,
- 20 joint-stock association or company, partnership, limited
- 21 partnership, limited liability company, association, business
- 22 trust, syndicate or other commercial or professional activity
- 23 organized under the laws of this Commonwealth or any other
- 24 jurisdiction.
- 25 "COVID-19." The novel coronavirus as identified in the
- 26 Governor's Proclamation of Disaster Emergency issued on March 6,
- 27 <u>2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020).</u>
- 28 "Government entity." A Commonwealth agency or political
- 29 <u>subdivision</u>.
- 30 "Political subdivision." A county, city, borough,

- 1 <u>incorporated town, township or school district of this</u>
- 2 <u>Commonwealth or an agency designated to act on behalf of a</u>
- 3 political subdivision.
- 4 § 5903. Requirement to show proof of vaccination prohibited.
- 5 No government entity shall require proof of vaccination
- 6 against COVID-19 to use any service, enter any building or
- 7 <u>undertake any activity within the territorial limits or the</u>
- 8 jurisdiction of the government entity.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
