## AN ACT

Amending the act of September 30, 1983 (P.L.160, No.39), entitled "An act establishing salaries and compensation of 2 certain public officials including justices and judges of 3 Statewide courts, judges of courts of common pleas, judges of the Philadelphia Municipal Court, judges of the Philadelphia 5 Traffic Court, district justices and the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the State Treasurer, the Auditor 6 7 General, the Attorney General and certain other State 8 officers and the salary and certain expenses of the members 9 of the General Assembly; and repealing certain inconsistent 10 acts," further providing for members of the General Assembly. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 4(a) of the act of September 30, 1983 14 15 (P.L.160, No.39), known as the Public Official Compensation Law, 16 is amended to read: Section 4. Members of the General Assembly. 17 18 Members salary, expense and mileage. --19 (1)The salary of members of the General Assembly shall 20 be \$47,000 per annum and mileage to and from their homes at 21 the rate of 20¢ per mile, circular, for each week a member was in actual attendance in session between their homes and 22

- 1 the State Capitol and, except as provided herein, no other
- 2 compensation shall be allowed whatsoever, except each member
- 3 of the General Assembly shall receive an allocation for
- 4 clerical assistance and other expenses incurred during his
- 5 term in connection with the duties of his office in the sum
- of \$7,500 annually; the salary to be payable in equal monthly
- 7 installments the first day of the month, including the
- 8 installment due December 1 of each even-numbered year.
- 9 (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), during the
- 10 <u>proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on</u>
- 11 <u>March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020),</u>
- and any renewal of the state of disaster emergency, no member
- of the General Assembly may receive a per diem or payment for
- 14 additional expenses. On a quarterly basis, unencumbered funds
- 15 <u>appropriated to the General Assembly dedicated to per diem or</u>
- 16 payment for additional expenses shall be transferred by the
- 17 State Treasurer to a restricted account in the General Fund
- 18 to be used by the Department of Community and Economic
- 19 Development to provide grants to small businesses through the
- 20 COVID-19 Relief Statewide Small Business Assistance
- 21 Program.
