AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, providing 5 for extended special education enrollment due to COVID-19; 6 and, in terms and courses of study, providing for optional 7 year of education due to COVID-19. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 11 12 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding sections 13 to read: 14 Section 1383. Extended Special Education Enrollment Due to 15 COVID-19.--(a) A student with a disability as defined in 22 Pa. Code § 14.101 (relating to definitions) who has reached 21 years 16 17 of age and is enrolled for the 2020-2021 school year is entitled

to attend a school entity for the 2021-2022 school year and the

school entity shall enroll the student if a parent or quardian

- 1 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
- 2 contrary, the following shall apply to a student enrolled in a
- 3 school entity under subsection (a):
- 4 (1) The school entity shall implement the student's IEP.
- 5 (2) The student's attendance shall be included in the school
- 6 <u>entity's average daily membership.</u>
- 7 (3) The school entity shall provide extended school year
- 8 services during the summer after the 2020-2021 school year in
- 9 accordance with the student's current IEP.
- 10 (c) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 11 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 12 <u>the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 13 <u>"IEP." An individualized education program established under</u>

- 16 "School entity." A school district, intermediate unit, area
- 17 career and technical school, charter school, regional charter
- 18 <u>school or cyber charter school.</u>
- 19 Section 1501.10. Optional Year of Education Due to COVID-
- 20 <u>19.--(a) It is the intent of the General Assembly to ensure</u>
- 21 that the present generation of school age children do not lose
- 22 <u>educational opportunities due to COVID-19.</u>
- 23 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for the
- 24 <u>2021-2022 school year, a parent or guardian may elect to have a</u>
- 25 child under the age of consent in a school entity repeat a grade
- 26 <u>level to make up for any lost educational opportunities due to</u>
- 27 COVID-19, notwithstanding whether the child met the requirements
- 28 to be promoted to the next grade level. A child at or over the
- 29 age of consent in a school entity may elect to repeat a grade
- 30 <u>level to make up for any lost educational opportunities due to</u>

- 1 COVID-19. The election under this subsection shall include
- 2 participation in academic or extracurricular activities,
- 3 including interscholastic athletics. Nothing under this
- 4 <u>subsection shall allow a child to have more years of eliqibility</u>
- 5 to participate in interscholastic athletics than they would have
- 6 had notwithstanding the election under this subsection.
- 7 (c) A school entity shall create an online application for a
- 8 parent or quardian to make the election under subsection (b) and
- 9 provide access to the application on its publicly accessible
- 10 Internet website.
- 11 (d) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 12 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 13 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 <u>"School entity." A school district, intermediate unit, area</u>
- 15 <u>career and technical school, charter school, cyber charter</u>
- 16 <u>school</u>, <u>regional charter school or nonpublic school entity</u>.
- 17 <u>"Interscholastic athletics." Athletic contests or</u>
- 18 competitions conducted between or among school entities situated
- 19 in a school district.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
