AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 13, 1988 (P.L.530, No.94), entitled "An
2 act establishing the Environmental Hearing Board as an
3 independent, quasi-judicial agency; providing for the
4 membership and staff, the powers and duties, the seats and
5 the existing members of the board; transferring certain
6 funds; and making repeals," further providing for
7 Environmental Hearing Board.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 3(d) of the act of July 13, 1988
11 (P.L.530, No.94), known as the Environmental Hearing Board Act,
12 is amended to read:

13 Section 3. Board.

14 * * *

15 (d) Terms.--The following apply:

16 (1) A member of the board shall serve for a term of
17 [six] five years or until a successor is appointed and
18 qualified. One of the additional members appointed under this
19 act shall serve an initial term of four years. Vacancies
20 shall be filled in the same manner as the original

1 appointment.

2 (2) After the expiration of a term of a member of the
3 board, the member shall be reappointed by the Governor with
4 the consent of a majority of the members elected to the
5 Senate.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
