13	hereby enacts as follows:
14	Section 1. The act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), known
15	as the Health Care Facilities Act, is amended by adding a

17	Section 822. Ambulatory surgical facility permitted surgical
18	procedures.
19	(a) Exception or waiver An ambulatory surgical facility
20	may seek an exception or waiver from the department for surgical
21	procedures not specified on the Centers for Medicare and
22	Medicaid Services (CMS) Ambulatory Surgical Center Covered

- 1 Procedures List (ASC-CPL), or its successor, or otherwise
- 2 provided by law or regulation.
- 3 (b) Permitted surgical procedures. -- The following are
- 4 permitted and shall not require an application or request for an
- 5 <u>exception or waiver from the department:</u>
- 6 (1) Surgical procedures permitted under Federal or State
- 7 law or regulation.
- 8 (2) Surgical procedures specified on the Centers for
- 9 Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) Ambulatory Surgical
- 10 Center Covered Procedures List (ASC-CPL), or its successor.
- 11 (c) Publication of surgical procedures. -- The department
- 12 <u>shall transmit notice to the Legislative Reference Bureau for</u>
- 13 <u>publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of the surgical</u>
- 14 procedures specified on the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid
- 15 <u>Services (CMS) Ambulatory Surgical Center Covered Procedures</u>
- 16 List (ASC-CPL), and any updates to the ASC-CPL made by the
- 17 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) shall be
- 18 transmitted by the department separately as notices to the
- 19 <u>Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania</u>
- 20 Bulletin. The department shall publish and maintain the complete
- 21 ASC-CPL on the department's publicly accessible Internet
- 22 website.
- 23 Section 2. The provisions of 28 Pa. Code § 551.21(d)(1), (2)
- 24 and (3) are abrogated. The provisions of 28 Pa.Code Chs. 51 and
- 25 551-571 are abrogated to the extent that they are inconsistent
- 26 with section 822 of the act.
- 27 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
