AN ACT

1 Designating the portion of Pennsylvania Route 309 from the
2 intersection with Pennsylvania Route 29 in Monroe Township,
3 Wyoming County, to the intersection with State Route 1026 in
4 Dallas Township, Luzerne County, as the Kunkle Firefighter
5 Edward L. Nulton, Sr., Memorial Highway.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Kunkle Firefighter Edward L. Nulton, Sr., Memorial
9 Highway.

10 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds that:

11 (1) Edward L. Nulton, Sr., was born July 30, 1956, and
12 was a resident of Beaumont, Monroe Township, Wyoming County.

13 (2) Mr. Nulton was a volunteer firefighter with the
14 Kunkle Volunteer Fire Company in Dallas Township, Luzerne
15 County, for 10 years.

16 (3) On September 21, 2018, Mr. Nulton was struck by a
17 dump truck while directing traffic at the scene of a
18 vehicular accident and sustained injuries.

19 (4) As a result of his injuries, Mr. Nulton died on
20 September 19, 2019.

1 (b) Designation.--The portion of Pennsylvania Route 309 from
2 the intersection with Pennsylvania Route 29 in Monroe Township,
3 Wyoming County, to the intersection with State Route 1026 in
4 Dallas Township, Luzerne County, is designated as the Kunkle
5 Firefighter Edward L. Nulton, Sr., Memorial Highway.

6 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
7 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
8 traffic in both directions on the highway.

9 Section 2. Effective date.

10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
