AN ACT

- 1 Establishing the Rural Coworking and Innovation Center Grant
- 2 Program, providing for requirements and imposing duties on
- the Department of Community and Economic Development.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Rural
- 8 Coworking and Innovation Center Grant Program Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Coworking and innovation center." A facility designed to
- 14 provide individuals with the infrastructure and equipment to
- 15 participate in an online workforce.
- 16 "Department." The Department of Community and Economic
- 17 Development of the Commonwealth.
- 18 "Entity." A municipality, institution of higher education,

- 1 private business, a nonprofit corporation organized for
- 2 community development purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the
- 3 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (Public Law 99-514, 26 U.S.C. § 1
- 4 et seq.) or a redevelopment authority created and organized
- 5 under the act of May 24, 1945 (P.L.991, No.385), known as the
- 6 Urban Redevelopment Law.
- 7 "Grant." A grant awarded as part of the Rural Coworking and
- 8 Innovation Center Grant Program.
- 9 "Grant program." The Rural Coworking and Innovation Center
- 10 Grant Program.
- "Municipality." A county, city, borough, incorporated town,
- 12 township or home rule, optional plan or optional charter
- 13 municipality, municipal authority in this Commonwealth and an
- 14 entity formed under 53 Pa.C.S. Ch. 23 Subch. A (relating to
- 15 intergovernmental cooperation).
- 16 "Rural county." A county that is defined as rural by the
- 17 Center for Rural Pennsylvania according to the most recent
- 18 census.
- 19 Section 3. The Rural Coworking and Innovation Center Grant
- 20 Program.
- 21 (a) Establishment. -- The Rural Coworking and Innovation
- 22 Center Grant Program is established and shall be administered by
- 23 the department.
- 24 (b) Objectives. -- The department may accomplish the following
- 25 objectives when administering the grant program:
- 26 (1) Construct or renovate a facility in one or more
- 27 rural counties to create one or more coworking and innovation
- centers.
- 29 (2) Extend and improve utilities and broadband service
- 30 connections to a coworking and innovation center in a rural

- 1 county.
- 2 (3) Purchase equipment, furniture and security systems
- 3 as part of a coworking and innovation center in a rural
- 4 county.
- 5 Section 4. Requirements.
- 6 (a) Regulations. -- The department may promulgate rules and
- 7 regulations establishing criteria for an entity to receive a
- 8 grant under this act. The rules and regulations shall include:
- 9 (1) The application form for submission to the
- 10 department.
- 11 (2) Entities that are eligible to apply for a grant.
- 12 (3) The method and formula for determining a grant
- award amount.
- 14 (4) The reporting requirements of grant recipients.
- 15 (b) Prioritization. -- In determining the amount of a grant
- 16 award, the department may prioritize projects:
- 17 (1) That will serve underserved communities.
- 18 (2) That demonstrate comprehensive planning by an
- 19 applicant that has limited access to financial resources,
- including financial resources from local or county
- 21 government.
- 22 (3) That maximize economic development opportunities in
- collaboration with the economic development needs or plans of
- an educational institution, county or municipality.
- 25 (c) Limitations.--A grant award may not be more than
- 26 \$500,000 and may only be awarded:
- 27 (1) If the grant program recipient agrees to provide a
- combination of funds, land, buildings or in-kind work in an
- amount equal to at least 25% of the grant award.
- 30 (2) For a grant awarded for construction or renovation

- of a coworking and innovation center, if the center will be
- 2 open and offered for an individual's use for seven or more
- 3 years in the rural county where the center is located.
- 4 (3) For a grant awarded for extending or improving
- 5 utilities or broadband service connections to a coworking and
- 6 innovation center or for purchasing equipment, furniture or
- 7 security systems for a coworking and innovation center, if
- 8 the center will be open and offered for an individual's use
- 9 for five or more years in the rural county where the center
- 10 is located.
- 11 (d) Ongoing operation. -- Grant money may not be awarded for
- 12 the ongoing operation or maintenance of a coworking and
- 13 innovation center.
- 14 (e) Audit.--Grant money awarded under this act shall be
- 15 subject to audit by the department.
- 16 Section 5. Effective date.
- 17 This act shall take effect in 90 days.
