AN ACT

1	Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled
2	"An Act relating to the finances of the State government;
3	providing for cancer control, prevention and research, for
4	ambulatory surgical center data collection, for the Joint
5	Underwriting Association, for entertainment business
6	financial management firms, for private dam financial
7	assurance and for reinstatement of item vetoes; providing for
8	the settlement, assessment, collection, and lien of taxes,
9	bonus, and all other accounts due the Commonwealth, the
10	collection and recovery of fees and other money or property
11	due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof,
12	including escheated property and the proceeds of its sale,
13	the custody and disbursement or other disposition of funds
14	and securities belonging to or in the possession of the
15	Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims against the
16	Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and appeals to the
17	courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to the
18	Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth and
19	all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting
20	moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof,
21	and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth,
22	authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes
23	to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of
24	section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of
25	Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of
26	certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every
27	department, board, commission, and officer of the State
28	government, every political subdivision of the State, and
29	certain officers of such subdivisions, every person,
30	association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or
31	collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws
32	imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or

1 2 3 4	other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the Commonwealth," providing for grant program local match relief.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known
8	as The Fiscal Code, is amended by adding an article to read:
9	<u>ARTICLE I-D</u>
10	GRANT PROGRAM LOCAL MATCH RELIEF
11	Section 101-D. Community Conservation Partnership Program.
12	(a) ApplicabilityThis section shall apply to grants for
13	the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2021, and for each fiscal
14	year thereafter.
15	(b) Local match exemptionNotwithstanding any other
16	provision of law, a municipality with a median household income
17	below 80% of the median household income for this Commonwealth
18	that is receiving financial assistance from funds available to
19	the Department of Community and Economic Development for
20	Community Conservation Partnership Program grants shall not be
21	required to provide local matching funds.
22	(c) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
23	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
24	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
25	"Municipality." As follows:
26	(1) Any of the following:
27	(i) A county, city, borough, incorporated town,
28	township or home rule municipality.
29	(ii) An official agency created by any of the
30	entities under subparagraph (i) under the laws of this
31	Commonwealth.
32	(2) An action taken by an official agency specified

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1	under paragraph (1)(ii) shall be first approved by the entity
2	that created the official agency.
3	Section 102-D. Greenways, Trails and Recreation Program.
4	(a) ApplicabilityThis section shall apply to grants for
5	the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2021, and for each fiscal
6	year thereafter.
7	(b) Local match exemption Notwithstanding any other
8	provision of law, a municipality with a median household income
9	below 80% of the median household income for this Commonwealth
10	that is receiving financial assistance from funds available to
11	the Commonwealth Financing Authority for Greenways, Trails and
12	<u>Recreation Program grants under 58 Pa.C.S. § 2315(a.1)(1)(iv)</u>
13	(relating to Statewide initiatives) shall not be required to
14	provide local matching funds.
15	(c) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
16	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
17	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
18	"Municipality." A county, city, borough, incorporated town
19	<u>or township.</u>
20	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
