AN ACT

1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in Pennsylvania Game Commission, further providing  
3 for organization of commission.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 301(a) and (b)(7) and (8) of Title 34 of  
7 the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and  
8 subsection (b) is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

9 301. Organization of commission.

10 (a) Composition.--The independent administrative commission  
11 known as the Pennsylvania Game Commission shall consist of  
12 [~~eight~~] nine competent citizens of this Commonwealth who shall  
13 be well informed on the subject of wildlife conservation and  
14 restoration and who shall be appointed by the Governor, by and  
15 with the advice and consent of a majority of the elected members  
16 of the Senate.

17 (b) Qualifications.--The members of the commission shall be  
18 appointed from the various geographical sections of this

1 Commonwealth so that one and only one shall be a resident of  
2 each of the following districts:

4 (7) The counties of Susquehanna, Wyoming, Luzerne,  
5 Lackawanna, [Carbon, Wayne, Pike and Monroe] Wayne and Pike,  
6 constituting the seventh district.

7 (8) The counties of [Schuylkill, Berks,] Chester,  
8 [Northampton, Lehigh,] Bucks, Montgomery, Philadelphia and  
9 Delaware, constituting the eighth district.

10 (9) The counties of Carbon, Monroe, Schuylkill, Berks,  
11 Northampton and Lehigh, constituting the ninth district.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
